














# Garbage Disposal Guide

●Items not separated appropriately or taken out on the wrong day will not be collected.

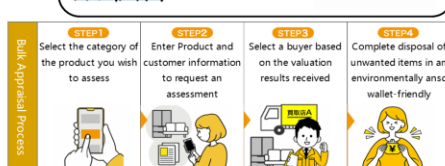
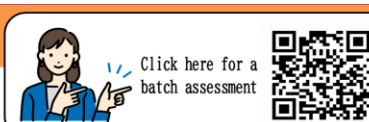

Would you like to consider reusing items that can be reused before paying to dispose of them as bulky garbage.  
For items that can be purchased on site, they can come to your home for collection.  
You can carry out a batch assesment of unnecessary items on the reuse platform 'Oikura' operated by Market Enterprise Co., Ltd which has a business partnership with Shiroy city.

※ Not all items can be picked up, as items that can be resold are subject to purchase.



■Home Appliance Recycling Law

Please request the retailer of original purchase or future purchase for replacement to pick up unnecessary items with fee.

In the case that the shop is far away or you do not know its place, call the waste disposal companies below:

( Recycling fee ) Collection and recycling fees will be charged for each item.

- ( How to bring it to the designated collection place by yourself )
1. Get the "Home Appliance Recycling Coupon" at the postal savings counter, fill in the payment slip and pay the charge at the post office.  
※To fill out a recycling ticket, you will need the "manufacturer name" and "screen size" for TVs, and the "manufacturer name" and "internal volume"for refrigerators and freezers.  
※Japan Post Bank transfer fee will be charged for each "Home Appliance Recycling Ticket".
  2. Take the home appliance you don't use and the paid "Home Appliance Recycling Ticket" to a designated receiving place nearby.  
※Please check the business days and reception hours in advance when you bring it to the designated receiving place.  
※Please contact the Shiroi City Hall Environment section for information on designated receiving place nearby.

■Items not separated appropriately or taken out on the wrong day will not be collected with a red card stuck on them. Please confirm the reason of not being collected and take out appropriately.
