DECONTAMINATION HAS BEEN COMPLETED IN AT PUBLIC FACILITIES

(公共施設の除染が完了)

Shiroi City, based on the city's decontamination implementation plan, has been conducting decontamination of public spaces such as nursery schools, kindergartens, elementary schools, junior high schools, parks, and detached houses. For the fiscal year 2012 plan, the decontamination work for all of the facilities has now finished.

Children's safety is the first priority

In order to make child safety the first priority, including at nursery schools, kindergartens, elementary schools and junior high schools across the whole city, radioactive volumes were monitored. In the FY2012, decontamination work was completed at 54 places, which were measured for radioactive substances of more than 0.23 microcievert per hour. Results of the implementation in FY2012 are shown on the table below. In FY2013, monitoring at public facilities will be conducted on an ongoing basis. Any place where the volume has increased again, or any partial high spots, will be decontaminated.

Decontamination for detached houses

Among 547 applicants (houses), 240 places were decontaminated. Monitoring will continue in FY2013. The city will accept applications in the planned areas, and execute decontamination as required, regardless of whether it's in the planned areas or children's living places or not.

Partial subsidy of expenses for measuring interior exposure to radiation

In order to reduce anxiety of radioactive exposure within internal areas, the city will partially subsidize expenses, using a measurement of the whole body to be measured. Details will be advised in the Shiroi Bulletin etc. as soon as they are confirmed.

Lecture meeting to be held

In order to share knowledge of radiation and radioactivity, the city will hold a lecture meeting after the conclusion of FY2012. The date will be notified in the Shiroi Bulletin etc. as soon as details are confirmed.

To secure safety for food materials

In order to secure safety and security, the city will continuously monitor radioactive substances of food materials for lunchs at nursery schools, kindergartens, elementary and junior high schools, and also local products brought to the city by the inner city farmers, residents and food-related enterprisers.

MAY IS BICYCLE SAFETY RIDING PROMOTION MONTH

~ Ride a bicycle safely by following traffic laws~ (5月は自転車安全利用推進月間です)

Bicycle riding is very easy and convenient for everyone. But if you don't follow traffic laws, it can be very dangerous and cause serious traffic accidents. May is bicycle safety ride promotion month, offering you a chance to confirm bicycle traffic laws.

Bicycles should be ridden on the roadway

Bicycles are categorized as light vehicles according to the Road Traffic Law, so they should be ridden on the roadway when a pedestrian overpass and roadway are divided. Ride on the left side of the roadway.

[Situations when bicycles can be ridden on a pedestrian overpass]

In the following situations, bicycles may be ridden on a pedestrian overpass, but please note that you should ride slowly and close to the roadway.

- There is a sign indicating pedestrians and bicycles have right of way.
- Bicycle riders are children under the age of 13 years, seniors over the age of 70 years, or persons with disabilities.
- When road construction works are being undertaken, or when parked cars or other obstacles make it difficult for you to ride on the roadway.

Bicycle safety ride rules

◆ Stop before crossings

When there is stop sign or you cannot see ahead very well, stop and make sure it is safe to continue, even if the road is familiar.

◆ Turn on the bicycle light when it is dark

When it is getting dark, turn on the bicycle light to let others notice your presence. Put a reflection seal on the side or back of the bicycle.

◆ It is forbidden for two persons to ride on one bicycle.

Chiba Pref. Traffic Law bans two persons from riding one bicycle, except when a person of 16 years or older rides with a child under 6 years. It is also forbidden to ride bicycles side by side (except where there is a sign indicating that it is possible to ride side by side), while holding an umbrella, or while using a mobile phone or headphones. You may be fined if you violate these rules.

Riding while drunk is forbidden.

Riding a bicycle while drunk is a violation of the Traffic Law, just as driving a car while drunk is a violation. Drunken riders have caused many traffic accidents. Never ride a bicycle while or after drinking, and never offer alcohol to bicycle riders.

Children must wear a helmet

When children ride a bicycle and fall down or have an accident, they often injure themselves by hitting their head. Children should wear a helmet when they ride or sit on the bicycle side chair.
