GENDER-EQUALITY CAMPAIGN WEEK (男女共同参画週間)

One week from June 23 till 29 every year is "Gender Equality Campaign Week". Why not think about this opportunity for "Man and Woman's Partnership"?

Addressing it one by one is important

In order to realize a "Gender Equality Society" and the opportunity to show each individual's personality and ability in the society of men and women, it is not only the responsibility of the City administration, but also the responsibility of every citizen to address gender equality.

The city is promoting the need for everyone to carry out equality in the home, community, workplace and school, as well as promoting study opportunities and providing information to enhance the awareness of men and women's equality.

"Only one woman in the group is not enough"

The government has agreed this year's catch phrase is "Only one woman in the group is not enough". This is the attractive catch phrase to promote a healthy Japan, by recognizing woman's activities in many fields in promoting gender equality.

The city, as well as the government and the prefecture, is setting up a numerical target to support the action plan for gender equality. Women's current level of participation is shown in the following table.

Expansion and effort are necessary for increasing women's participation

According to the table below, the city's current values for women's participation are generally better than those of the prefecture or states' rates of participation. As some values are less than the prefecture or state's average values, more effort and expansion is necessary. What is the key to solving this issue? The city asked Ms. Eiko Muto (living in Fuku), the city's agricultural member who is working in the agricultural field, her ideas on how to increase woman's participation.

♦ Leave the comfort of your home

On the occasion that I was nominated as a member of agriculture, I participated in the meetings for farm management in Chiba-ken and outside of Chiba, where I met various people to talk with, and I learned a lot. There are still many women who hesitate to go out of their homes, and in order to do so, it is important to have the understanding of your family. I myself could fortunately get it.

Women go out, learn and enjoy, and then bring their learnings back home, which is something new and good for the family, and for the women.

♦ Men and women do something similar

I learn lots at the gatherings of agricultural committees. I take advantage of what I learn, and give advice, discuss legal matters about related information, or my experience in the past, etc., when I am asked in the community. Men officials once asked me what they, men, should ask us, women, but I thought that it was ridiculous to ask women about some special works just because they are women. It is important that we, women, as well as men, are able to learn, work and speak their opinions. As a result, a new point of view will be found.

◆ Talk

At first, it was very difficult for me to talk in the conference. I joined classes on how to participate in dialogues. I made a one minute speech in the class. Previously, Japanese people were not used to speaking in front of others. But now it is natural to talk in the presence of people. I, after my accumulated experience of talking, can now speak freely. Now I only make a resume, and talk naturally, and can repeat important parts when necessary. I continue talking with a nervous energy, but the listeners don't seem to notice.

♦ What I like to advise

I recommend that you enjoy your life, agriculture and study with a joyful heart. Don't say "it is difficult", or "I can't go out anywhere". I hope even young people go out as much as possible and freely with a positive mind, and they experience many things.

To stay in one's old circumstances is an easy thing, but it makes it harder to get out of it. It is difficult to change yourself when you remain in the same situation. To jump out of your old circumstances is a good opportunity to try something new.

NOTICE FROM RESIDENT SECTION (市民課からお知らせ)

◆ "Basic Resident Register Network System" to start for foreign residents

"The basic resident register network" (or Juki Net) is a system that operates nationwide, allowing people to be commonly identified through the resident basic register.

The Juki Net will also be applied to foreign residents from Monday, July 8. The city will send all residents who have yet registered a "resident's card code notification", and you are asked to keep it carefully.

Upon application, a "basic resident register card" (or Juki card) will be issued, for a fee.

◆ Issue of electronic certificate or deletion desk will be closed on Monday, 29 and Tuesday, 30.

The city will close the desk service on 29 and 30 July, which may cause some inconvenience to residents for those two days.

TAX PAYMENT/PAYING NOTIFICATION AND FINAL NOTICE TO BE FORWARDED – NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE TAX AND PUBLIC MEDICAL CARE INSURANCE PREMIUM FOR THE AGED

(OVER 75 YEARS OLD) - (納税・納入通知書、決定通知書を送付-国民健康保険税・後期高齢者医療保険料)

The National Health Insurance or Public Medical Care Insurance is a mutual aid system to prepare for any unexpected sickness or injury. Insured persons pay a medical expense premium according to their income amount.

Payment notice will be mailed

[Ordinary payment]

For statement of payment or automatic withdrawal from one's bank account, a payment notice will be mailed in the middle of July.

The date of payment will be the end of each month, for eight months, from July to February in the following year. Please make sure to pay at a financial institute, etc. by the due date to ensure stable management of the health insurance system. For those who choose to pay by an automatic bank withdrawal, please ensure that there are sufficient funds in the bank account on the payment date.

[Special payment]

The tax or premium for those who receive an annual pension amount of one hundred eighty thousand yen or over, the premium will be withdrawn from their pension. The statement of payment will be sent to you at the end of July. Please check the amount.

[Those who pay by both ordinary and special payments]

Special payments will start in October. The payment notice will be sent in the middle of July. Until the special payments start, please pay due amounts at the bank, etc.

EARLY CONSULTATION IS RECOMMENDED FOR TAX PAYMENT (納税相談は早めに)

Those who experience difficulty in paying their National Health Insurance tax or Public Medical Care Insurance Premium within the date of payment for any reason are recommended to consult the Hoken Nenkin-ka or Insurance and Pension desk for payment by installments, etc.

Some exemptions of the tax are available in case of disaster, etc. Please ask for more details.
