


# MUTUAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT CONCLUDED WITH DATE CITY IN THE EVENT OF DISASTER (伊達市と災害時相互応援協定を締結)

#### Proceeding with collaboration and cooperation towards disaster reduction

Shiroi city concluded "an agreement for mutual cooperation in the event of a large scale disaster" with Date city, Fukushima prefecture on July 10.

The agreement aims to provide mutually beneficial and smooth assistance for emergency restoration and reconstruction measures in the event of a large scale disaster in either city. This is the first time that Shiroi city has concluded such an agreement with a remote autonomy.

The city, learning from the Great East Japan Disaster, has studied the necessity for assistance with a remote city that will not experience and suffer from a coinciding disaster.

Children from both cities have been conducting goodwill exchanges under the name of "Asobanekai" since 1989. Based on this existing relationship, Shiroi city and Date city (formerly the children's Tsukidate town in Fukushima prefecture) have concluded the mutual cooperation agreement.

The ceremony to mark the finalization of the agreement was held in the Date City Office, and attended by hosting Mayor Nishida and Shiroi Mayor Izawa, who confirmed mutual cooperation in the event of disasters and reduction of damages.

#### **Contents of cooperation agreement**

- · Temporary receiving of affected persons.
- · Emergency measures for food and water, and provision of necessary goods and materials for restoration.
- Dispatch of the necessary number of city staff for emergency disaster and restoration activities.
- In addition, specially requested matters.

Date city is located north of Fukushima prefecture, and is made up of five former towns - Date, Yanagawa, Hobara, Ryozen and Tsukidate - which merged and became a city on January 1, 2006.

### **CITY CIRCLE BUS "NASHII" ROUTE AND TIME TABLE TO BE CHANGED AS OF SEPTEMBER 1** (循環バス「ナッシー号」は9月1日から一部新ルート・時刻で運行)

The city's familiar circle bus "Nashii" will change parts of its route, as the result of users' opinions and a regional public transport conference, in order to enhance services.

#### **Main Changes**

• One extra bus on the Nishi route

Departure from City Office at 7 a.m. for Kamagaya General Hospital arriving at 7:50 a.m. This operation is for the convenience of school children due to a school zone change (Nishi-shiroi 3 and 4 chome) from Oyamaguchi Elementary school to Nanatsugidai school in April 2013.

• The terminal stop of the last operation on the Nishi and Minami routes, and the first bus starting point on the Higashi route is to change.

At present the last operation on the Nishi and Minami routes' terminal are Nishi-shiroi station, and the starting point of the first bus on the Higashi route is Shiroi station. Both the starting and terminal points will change to the Shiroi city office.

• The terminal point on the Kita route to change to "Tenjin-mae"

The current terminal point on the Kita route is "Dai-ichi Elementary school". This will change to "Tenjin-mae". There are clinics and a supermarket nearby.

### • Improvement of transfer time

Currently the arrival time on the Higashi route and the starting time on the Minami route at the City office occur at the same time, at 2:10 p.m. This does not provide enough time for passengers to transfer from one service to another. A ten minute allowance will now be made for user's convenience.

X In order to get rid of traffic congestion toward Shin-Kamagaya, a time table adjustment and change of the names for bus stops will be undertaken. The names will change from "Shiroi" to "Shiroi community center", and from "Sakai Iryo Shiroi Kojo-mae" to "Rihamode Villa Shiroi".

• Sunday bus operations will be suspended, despite a high level of demand, due to 68% fewer users on a Sunday compared to on weekdays. A similar situation is the neighborhood bus services, including the community bus. Approximately 12 million yen of extra expense is required for the Sunday operation.

#### New Route Map and Time Table

A new bus route map and time table will be distributed from the first floor information desk in the city office and at each community center. Or visit the city homepage. Bus operation dates and fares will remain unchanged. **Bus operation days**: Monday through Saturday

Services are suspended on Sundays, holidays, at year-end and beginning of the year (Dec. 29 – Jan. 3). The student's commuting bus is also suspended during school holidays.

#### Fares

150 yen for high school students and above. 100 yen for junior high students. 50 yen for elementary school children and disabled persons. (50 yen for one disabled person's helper). Free of charge for preschool children.

#### **Coupon ticket**

1,000 yen for adult of ¥50 x 24 sheets. 1,000 yen for "silver-aged" tickets of ¥50 x 30 sheets (available for persons 70 years old or above)

X Coupons are available in the Nassiy bus, Chiba rainbow bus co. Shiroi Shako, Funabashi Shin-keisei bus co. Kamagaya office.

IC cards (PASMO or Suica) can also be used.

However elementary, junior high students and the disabled are requested to inform the driver. Transferring between services

The fare for the Nassiy bus is a 'ride through' system. When a user wants to transfer between buses, no additional fare is required. However, the transferring bus stops are only "Shiroi city office" and "Nishi-shiroi station". If transferring between services, please make sure to get a transferring ticket from the driver, etc.

# FOR SINGLE PARENT FAMILIES (母子、父子家庭の人へ)

Children's allowance and medical aid for children are available for single parents raising a child under 18 years of age, or a disabled child under 20 years of age at the end of the Financial Year (FY). Please apply to receive the allowance. Eligible children include the following:

- Those who don't live with their mother or father after their parent's divorce
- Those whose mother or father has died (except when they receive a public pension or aid to a surviving family)
- Those whose mother or father has a serious handicap (at the 1<sup>st</sup> rank of handicap of the national pension)
- Those whose mother or father is unknown to be dead or alive
- Those who have been abandoned by a mother or father for more than one year
- Those whose mother or father is on probation
- Those whose mother or father has been taken into custody for more than one year
- Those whose mother is not married and has a child
- Those who have no record of their birth condition

#### Applications for a child allowance certificate

Those who were not eligible for child allowance because of the income limit in FY 2012, and who want to apply for the allowance this year, are asked to make an application at Jido-katei-ka (Child and Family Section) for allowance certification. If you are certified, the allowance will be paid from the next month of your application. The income limit is shown in the table below.

\* Those who made a report for the allowance and were not certified will receive a report form for FY 2013 in August, and do not need to make an application.

#### Necessary items to accompany an application

A copy of your family register, residential register (for all family members), for those who moved to Shiroi city after January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2013 FY 2013 taxation certification, bank account book of applicant's name, family name seal X According to individual family situations, other documents may also be necessary.

#### Medical allowance for single parent families

When single-parent family members have medical treatment (for example, hospitalization, outpatient treatment, getting medicine, etc.), a part of the cost covered by health insurance will be subsided.

Necessary items to accompany an application:

Health insurance book, a copy of the family registration, residential registration (for all family members), for those who moved to Shiroi city after January  $2^{nd}$ , 2013 FY 2013 taxation certification, family name seal, report form (only for a single parent by divorce)  $\times$  Those who make an application for a child allowance don't need to submit any documents except their health insurance book.

• Present condition report should be submitted to receive child allowance and medical allowance for single parent families

For those who are receiving the allowance, the present condition report form will be sent in August. Please complete the form according to conditions as at August  $1^{st}$ , and submit it to receive the allowance from August.

#### **IMPORTANCE OF PREVENTING HEAT STROKE** (熱中症は予防が大切)

Heat stroke occurs during periods of high temperature when a person cannot adjust their body temperature naturally, i.e. by widening of blood vessels or sweating, and an imbalance of body moisture. The aged, infants, persons with a chronic disease or poor health conditions are especially prone to suffer from heat stroke, and must be taken care of. If a person suffers from serious heat stroke, there is a chance of death.

But if you know how to prevent heat stroke and conduct proper first aid, you can reduce the risk of heat stroke, or remove the effects of heat stroke if it occurs.

#### [Preventive measures]

"Hydration" and "heat avoidance" are important. When a person's body temperature suddenly rises, you must be careful with treatment.

- Drink water often, but don't take drinks that have a diuretic effect (e.g. caffeine-based drinks).
- Use an air conditioner or fan as needed when it's hot don't delay using them.
- Wear cool clothes such as a half sleeve shirt, and use a parasol or hat when going out.
- X The aged should drink water continuously even if they don't feel thirsty, and use the air conditioner or a fan when the room temperature exceeds 28 degrees Celsius

#### [Some symptoms that could indicate a case of heat stroke]

Some of these symptoms may appear, depending on seriousness of the case.

Slight degree: Dizziness, feeling dizzy while standing up, muscle pain, or non-stop sweating

Middle degree: Headache, nausea, feelings of boredom

Severe degree: Unconsciousness, convulsion, high body temperature, inappropriate response when called, inability to walk straight

#### [In cases of heat stroke]

When some one unfortunately suffers from heat stroke, undertake the following measures:

• Give him/her some water or sport drinks (20 - 40 grams of sugar, 3 grams of salt, a little drop of lemon per a liter of water may be used as a substitute).

- Move him/her to a cool place
- Loosen their clothing and cool down their neck and armpits (e.g. with a cold, wet flannel)
- If the person doesn't recover, call for an ambulance immediately
- X Symptoms of heat stroke change as time elapses, so it is important to watch the patient's condition carefully. Even if a patient has a slight degree of heat stroke, keep watching him/her and don't leave them alone. If symptoms worsen, call an ambulance immediately.

## HAVE YOU BOUGHT INSURANCE FOR "MUTUAL AID OF TRAFFIC ACCIDENT" YET?

(交通災害共済に加入しませんか)

A public corporation runs a beneficial traffic insurance scheme to provide citizens with a not for profit mutual aid system. If you happen to become an unfortunate victim of an accident, a maximum of 1.5 million yen will be paid to you as 'sympathy money'. An annual premium for the insurance is only 700 yen.

August is a wholesale campaign month for the insurance scheme. It is recommended that you buy the insurance coverage during this campaign period.

The city office accepts applications throughout the year.

However, applications will be extraordinarily accepted on the following dates and places shown in the table below. \* Applications by postal mail will not be accepted.

Insurance term: Sunday, September 1, 2013 - Sunday, August 31, 201

Application of insurance: A certificate stating details of a traffic accident involving a car or a motor-bike, must be issued by the authorities

\* Even single-person accidents must be reported to a police station

Sum of sympathy payment: Per person: 1.5 million yen in case of death, 20,000 -500,000 yen in case of injury,

500,000 yen in case of disability resulting from an injury (physically handicapped category1 and 2), 100,000 yen in case of a child becoming an orphan due to a traffic accident.

Annual Premium: 700 yen
