# EMMERGENCY DEMAND CONCERNING THE FUNDAMENTAL POLICY FOR "CHILDREN AND VICTIM SUPPORT LAW" (DRAFT) WAS SUBMITTED TO THE RECONSTRUCTION AGENCY

(復興庁へ「子ども・被災者支援法」基本方針(案)にかかる緊急要望書を提出しました)

A letter of demand concerning the fundamental policy of "Children and victim support law for nuclear electric generation plants damage" (draft) was submitted to the Reconstruction Agency on October 3. Nine city mayors in Chiba prefecture whose areas were designated as important survey cities contaminated by nuclear substances signed the letter. The mayors and support staff went to the Reconstruction Agency and submitted the letter to the Minister of Reconstruction Agency.

#### Outline of the demand letter

- \* Various kinds of support contained in the policy should be widely applied to other cities and towns in addition to the designated areas, with consideration of the actual situations of environmental contamination and citizen's uneasiness caused by the accident at the Tokyo Electric Co.'s Fukushima Daiichi atomic power generation plants.
- \* Support for health management and medical policy should be promoted with special consideration to the children and pregnant women in the important survey areas contaminated.
- \* Investigation of the above policy should reflect the opinions of victims, and the process should be open with the highest levels of transparency.
- \* All expenses related to the above policy should be borne by the government.

Further, Mayor Izawa strongly demanded that "Children and pregnant women's health management be specially taken care of".

**Qualifications**: The guardian needs to meet one of the following conditions and have difficulty in taking care of a child at home (except when family members such as grandparents can take care of the child)

- Working daily
- Before or after mother's childbirth
- The guardian's illness, injury, or need to take care of the sick or the disabled, etc.
- Victims suffering from fire, flood, or other disaster and undertaking repairs to their property

#### IN CASE OF CHILD'S SUDDEN ILLNESS (子供の急病の際に)

Parents and guardians should be prepared when children in their care suddenly fall ill. To ensure calmness when there is an emergency health situation for a child, you should always have a known family doctor, and be aware of medical facilities to consult on holidays or at night.
