REQUEST TO SAVE ELECTRICITY IN THE WINTER SEASON (冬季節電に協力を)

All households are encouraged to save power whenever possible

A shortage of electricity is expected due to the increased use of heating appliances when the cold winter weather arrives.

With consideration of the current global warming situation, citizens are encouraged to save electricity whenever it is reasonably possible to do so. Please refer to the following examples of electricity saving.

• Set your air conditioner temperature to a setting that's comfortable for wearing with another set of clothing over the top.

- Ensure there is air circulation in the room, as warm air gathers near the ceiling
- · Refrain from using an electric pot or rice cooker for extended periods of time

Shiroi city's target for Power Saving

The city has developed the "Shiroi Power Saving Action Guideline" for public facilities to implement ongoing power saving measures.

Power saving actions

• The heating temperature in public facilities will be set at 19 $^{\circ}$ C in winter (28 $^{\circ}$ C in summer).

- * The facility manager may change the temperature when considering the health of users of the facility, including use by infants, children and the aged.
- · Office staff are encouraged to wear a sweater or vest; so called "warm biz", or without necktie or coat, "cool biz".
- Where two or more elevators are available for use, the number of elevators in operation will be controlled.
- Unnecessary lights will be turned off as often as possible.
- Usage of electric pots and coffee makers will be limited as often as possible.
- Individual PCs will be set to standby mode.
- · Overtime work will not occur on Wednesdays: "no overtime work day".
- Auto-vendor staff are requested to use the power saving setting.
- There will be efforts to make a green curtain during the summer.

SETTLEMENT OF FY2012 ACOUNT (平成 24 年度決算)

Settlement of General Account

The general account of the city's income (revenue) was 19,474,470 thousand yen (including 738,570 thousand yen of withdrawal from the city's saving – the so-called 'financial adjustment fund'), and outgoing expenditure was 18,417,830 thousand yen. The balance of 1,056,640 thousand yen was in the black, which included 148,120 thousand yen from an additional project within the government supplementary budget, uncompleted projects in FY2012 due to bad weather, and those budgets that were forwarded to FY2013. Therefore, the actual balance in FY2012 was 908,520 thousand yen in the black.

• **Revenue** (increase of City Bond)

The 'City bond' (loan) increased by 354,850 thousand yen (30.3%) compared with FY2011 due to school building extensions and improvements. By unification and abolition of the Fund, 1,006,620 thousand yen was temporarily put into the general affairs' account. As a result, "the money transferred from other account" increased by 9.3% for the total revenue. Though the 'city tax', which was about 50% of the revenue, it decreased by 153,010 thousand yen (1.7%) compared with FY2011 due to the revaluation of the real estate property. Total revenue increased by 1,793,380 thousand yen (10.1%).

• **Expenditure** (increase of Education Expenses)

'Education expenses' increased by 1,117,410 thousand yen (56.0%) compared with FY2011 due to extension work at Nanatsugidai Elementary School. The newly established fund for 'public facility development' resulted in a saving of 1,006,620 thousand yen. As a result, the 'general affairs' account increased.

Total expenditure increased by 1,817,170 thousand yen (10.9%) compared with FY2011.

Uncompleted projects (improvement of Oyamaguchi Junior High School gymnasium etc.) were forwarded to FY2013.

MAIN UNDERTAKINGS EXECUTED IN FY2012 (平成 24 年度に実施した主な事業)

Among FY2012 undertakings, the major and new projects are identified as follows. These projects support the city's future image as detailed in the Fourth Comprehensive Plan - to realize "Safe and healthy Shiroi building together with citizens".

Other undertakings of the city for FY2012 are shown on the city's home-page.

[Build-up the city with safe child rearing]

• Medial expense subsidies for children: 182,079 thousand yen

Subsidized medical expenses for 4th through 6th grade elementary school children out-patients from April, and for junior high students in-patients from December.

• Enlargement of elementary school building: 310,170 thousand yen

Nanatsugidai elementary school building was extended due to a shortage of classrooms. This was a result of the change to the Oyamaguchi school zone due to the rapid increase in children.

[Build-up the city for safe and comfortable living]

• Promotion of a regional disaster plan: 9,034 thousand yen

To review the regional disaster plan, the city conducted a survey to assess disaster-proofing, and developed a hazard map of comprehensive disaster prevention.

• Preventive measures for aged people: 11,513 thousand yen

For persons in aged care, classes were held, and campaigns and education were conducted in the community.

[Build-up the city for citizens' healthy lives]

Subsidy for thorough medical checkup expenses: 6,463 thousand yen

For early detection and early treatment, partial subsidies for thorough medical and brain checkups were granted to citizens aged over 40 years and less than 75 years old who were insured with the national health insurance.

[Build-up the city for citizens' active lives]

Middle/small enterprises' active support project: 240 thousand yen

To stimulate the regional economy and promote comfortable living, the city established an ordinance for industrial promotion.

[Build-up a green-rich and comfortable city]

Conservation of resources and energy promoting project: 13,973 thousand yen

- A subsidy was granted to those who installed a solar generation system to their house to reduce the burden on the environment.
- · City road repairs and maintenance projects: 163,331 thousand yen

Badly damaged pavements and sewerage facilities were repaired.

[Projects other than the original implementation plan]

Radioactive substances measures: 300,482 thousand yen

In order to secure citizens' safety and security, the city conducted periodical measurements of radioactive values, decontamination of public facilities, monitoring of agricultural food and food materials for school lunch, and lending out an instrument to measure radioactive value, etc.

• NEET, staying indoors measures: 198 thousand

For those people, or their families, who have worried about NEET or keeping indoors, and have no one to ask for help, the city held consultations with mental health expert twice a month (July – March) at each public center, and medical or educational specialists were introduced as needed.

Application for periodic usage of the City bicycle park ~ Usage from April 2014 ~

From December 3rd (Tue) to 20th(Fri) applications for periodic usage of the Shiroi Ekimae and Nishi-shiroi Ekimae bicycle parks are being accepted.

Those who have already used the parks need to re-apply. The periodic parking fee will be changed during FY 2014.

Application for periodic usage

You can apply for one bicycle per person, or for one motor bike (50cc and less), park at Shiroi 3^{rd} parking, or Nishi-shiroi 1^{st} and 2^{nd} parking. Applications made in the name of a family member who doesn't use the parking cannot be accepted, as these will increase the number of applications to be available for genuine users.
