# LET'S PREPARE FOR HEAVY RAIN OR EARTH & SAND DAMAGE

## (大雨や土砂災害に備えよう)

WHY NOT UTILIZE A COMPREHENSIVE HAZARD MAP FOR DISASTER PREVENTION? (総合防災ハザードマップの活用を)

### ~~ Collection of information and early refuge ~~

Recently localized torrential downpours (irregular heavy rain), flooding and landslide damage due to typhoons have occurred often. To protect oneself from storm and flood damage, it is important to collect early weather information and take quick refuge when there is a threat of danger.

#### How to protect oneself from earth and sand damage

Earth and sand damage (here-in after referred to as "E&S damage") occurred in Hiroshima prefecture in August 2014, taking a heavy toll of more than 70 of lives. E&S damages, including landslides, are a fearful disaster. A destructive power can hit many lives and houses in a moment. Japan, being surrounded by hills and mountains, is prone to disasters caused by typhoons and torrential downpours.

Dangerous areas for E&S damage in the city are shown on the city and Chiba prefecture's homepages. (In the city, 25 places have been identified as dangerous places, and 11 of these places are designated as E&S damage warning or special warning places.)

The "Comprehensive hazard map for disaster prevention" identifies those E&S damage warning

places. Please check and make sure if your house or your neighbors' houses are designated as being in the E&S damage warning area.

#### Three points to prepare against heavy rain or E&S damage

E&S damage is an unforeseen, dangerous disaster. It is recommended that everyone prepare against E&S damage. Please be aware of the following three points:

- ① In case of a typhoon or heavy rain, confirm if your house is, or is not, located in an "E&S damage warning area".
- 2 When it starts raining, pay attention to the warning information for E&S damage or rainfall volume.
- ③ When "the warning information for E&S damage" has been announced, take refuge as soon as possible. If a heavy rainfall is expected at night, take refuge before dark.

#### What is "warning information for E&S damage"?

When a danger for E&S damage becomes high due to heavy rain, Chiba prefectural government and Choshi Meteorological Observatory will make a joint announcement of "information of disaster prevention" specifying the possible corresponding names of the city, town and village, as a reference to the city's disaster prevention activity or residence self-refuge decision.

#### When is the warning announced?

During heavy rainfall, a warning announcement will be made based on actual rainfall volume and the estimated amount for the next one or two hours.

#### How is it announced?

It will be announced on TV, radio, internet, etc. The city will deliver it by means of "Shiroi mail delivery service" which is connected with a nationwide simultaneous alert system (J-alert).

#### What shall we do when it is announced?

When the announcement is made by TV or radio, residents in low-lying areas or steep slope areas must take precautions, as the area is prone to possible landslides, etc. Pay attention to the weather information as well as the city's information.

If there is no warning information, everyone should still be careful and watchful for any changes in slope areas. If something unusual is observed, you should take immediate refuge in an identified "safe place".

## APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO "NURSERY SCHOOLS", "HOME NURSERY" FOR FY2015 (平成 27 年度「保育所入所」「家庭的保育利用」の申し込み)

Shiroi city will accept applications for new admissions to nursery schools, authorization for utilization, and application to home-visit nursing for FY2015.

Based on the newly established "Child/child-rearing support system" starting in FY2015, guardians

who request their children utilize nursery schools, etc. are required to submit an authorization (procedure to authorize children's necessity for nursing). For application, submission of the authorization is also necessary.

There are three classifications, as follows. Education, nursing or available time are different by the classification.

- ③ Guardian's illness or injury
- ④ Relative's nursing care/being looked after in the same house or long hospitalization
- (5) Restoration of disaster (fire damage, etc.)

Ask directly to the nursing related section in each citiy where the child wants to enter, and submit the form to Shiroi city *Jido Katei-ka* (Child and Family Section) <u>ten days before the deadline of the out-of-city nursery school.</u>

Complete the designated form (available at *Jido Katei-ka* (Child and Family Section), the city home-page, each Nursing school except Hanabusa nursing school) and submit it to Shiroi city *Jido Katei-ka* (Child and Family Section Tel. 497-3488) within the application period.
