SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013(平成 25 年度決算)

Shiroi City has conducted the administrative management of its accounts, including subsidies from the state and prefecture, loans and taxes paid by citizens.

The city's settlement of accounts will publicize how much money was spent, and how it was spent in fiscal year 2013.

Settlement of General Account

The general account of the city's income (revenue) was 18,820,580 thousand yen (including 535,420 thousand yen of withdrawal from the city's savings - so called 'financial adjustment fund'), and outgoing expenditure was 17,881,120 thousand yen.

The balance of 939,460 thousand yen was in the black, which included 46,510 thousand yen from an additional project within the government supplementary budget, but the project was uncompleted and forwarded to the following fiscal year of 2014. Therefore, the actual balance in FY2013 was 892,9510 thousand yen in the black.

◆ Revenue (money transferred from the fund decreased)

The city's saving fund account in FY2012 was unified-and-abolished, with 1,006,620 thousand yen transferred from the abolished fund into the general account due to a decrease in revenue in FY2013 of 653,890 thousand yen (3.5%).

However, the city tax, which is about 50 percent of the revenue, increased by 148,120 thousand yen (1.7% more than FY2012) due to an increase in population.

◆ Expenditure (general affairs expenses decreased)

As an Undertaking Association for Inzai District Environmental Development, which runs garbage

disposal, the Inzai Funeral Hall and Cemetery, made a loan repayment in advance, each association paid its allotment. By doing this, the expense of "public hygiene" increased by 395,590 thousand yen (19.9%) more than FY2012. However, the "fund for the public facility development" was established in FY2012. This made the reserved fund decrease by 1,006,620 thousand yen, and consequently the "general affairs" expense decreased by 802,900 thousand yen (22.7%). Total expenditure of 536,710 thousand yen (2.9%) was less than that of FY2012.

Expenses for uncompleted projects of large scale improvement (Shiroi Daiichi Elementary School etc.), totaling 879,870 thousand yen for FY2013 were forwarded to FY2014 for implementation.

MAIN UNDERTAKINGS IMPLEMENTED IN FY 2013 (平成 25 年度に実施した主な事業)

Among FY2013 undertakings, the major and new projects are identified as follows. These projects support the city's future image as detailed in the Fourth Comprehensive Plan, the latter basic plans – to realize a "Safe and healthy Shiroi, building together with citizens".

Other major results of the undertakings are shown on the city's home-page.

Build-up of the city for safe child rearing

Medical expense subsidies for children: 203,183 thousand yen

Subsidized medical expenses until 6th grade elementary school children for out-patients, and junior high school children for in-patients.

Build-up of the city for safe and comfortable living

Crime prevention measures: 453 thousand yen

In order to build-up the community patrol system with citizens' cooperation, a lecture class was conducted for blue-light patrol cars. The blue light vehicles were lent out to the trainees.

Build-up of the city for citizens' healthy lives

Specified health instructor project: 1,141 thousand yen

Specified health instructors conducted residents' interviews at the special health checkup places so that everyone may easily receive their first health consultation.

Build-up of the city for the citizens' healthy activities

Agricultural produce technology and managing improvement assistance: 12,802 thousand yen Subsidies were granted to replace multi-purpose preventive nets for special products of pear to avoid hail damage.

Build-up a green-rich and comfortable city

Conservation of resources and energy promoting project: 19,277 thousand yen

Partial subsidies were granted to residents who installed a solar power generating system or high quality hot water heater to promote the use of renewable energy in order to reduce the environmental burden and prevent greenhouse gas emissions.

As to the installation of solar power generating systems, more subsidies were granted if the

system was installed by city-based contractors, to promote their industry.

• Projects other than those in the original implementation plan

Subsidies for housing reform: 6,515 thousand yen

Subsidies were granted for housing reform by city-based contractors in order to enhance the living environment, activate in-city housing-related industry, and create employment.

Management of project for school library: 16,707 thousand yen

Placement of support teachers for reading promotion to assist children's independent study, utilizing the school library for each subject.

LET'S TAKE PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES AGAINST INFLUENZA(インフルエンザの予防)

"Seasonal influenza" spreads at its peak around January through February. The reason is that the virus can live a long time in the low temperature and dry cold air, and the condition of people's mucous membrane of nose and mouth in dry and cold conditions. It is also said that in the year-end and beginning of the year, many people move around, and the virus spreads throughout the whole country. ◆ Points of influenza prevention

- Rest well, develop strength, build resistance and eat a balanced nutritious diet.
- Utilize a humidifier and maintain proper temperature and humidity
- Practice a good "cough etiquette"

♦ "Cough etiquette"

- Wear a mask while coughing and sneezing
- Cover your mouth and nose with tissue paper while coughing and sneezing, keep away from others as far as one meter or two.
- Throw used tissues for runny noses into the trash can promptly
- Wash hands promptly after covering your running nose or after coughing

~ MY NUMBER SYSTEM ~ SOCIAL SECURITY AND TAX NUMBER SYSTEM TO START (マイナンバー制度~社会保障・税番号制度開始)

The "Act on the Use of Numbers to Identify a Specific Individual in the Administrative Procedure" was enacted in May 2013, and the Social Security and Tax Number Systems will be introduced.

At present, Shiroi city is working to record individual numbers and notify citizens in October 2015, and is working to start the utilization of the individual numbers from January 2016.

What is the 'My Number' system?

At present the government, prefecture, city, town, and village have and are managing each individual's information. By controlling such information by individual Social Security and Tax

Number, so-called 'My Number', different organizations are able to exchange necessary information in the fields of social security, tax, disaster management etc.

What is the 'My Number' (individual number)?

From October 2015, the city will notify all citizens who have resident registration (including foreign nationality) of their twelve digit individual number.

Whoever wants the card can have one issued. The card will be an IC card with individual number and face photo, which may be used as an ID card.

Utilization of 'My Number'

The 'My Number card' will be used for administrative procedures such as social security, tax and disaster prevention.

This card will be used for administrative works described in laws or regulations. The number will be necessary for such applications. Private enterprises will handle this number within the limits described by the law, such as for public social insurance or tax deductions from income, etc. So your employing company will require the number.

From 2017 the coordination of information among government departments and local municipalities is scheduled using these numbers.

It is important 'My Number' is used for one's life time

To avoid so called 'successful impersonation', very strict personal checks are necessary to use the number.

To use or to lend 'My Number' other than for the purpose of laws or regulations is not allowed. Illegal use or improper loan of 'My Number' by another person may result in punishment.
