Holiday of September - 9/18 *Keirou no Hi* (Respect for the Aged Day) The third Monday of September is assigned to Respect for the Aged Day. Its purpose is to honor the elderlies who had contributed to the society and to celebrate their long life. Even though the original concept was started from a small village, later it was included in national holidays on 1966.

Please Be Prepared for Any Natural Disasters. (災害から冷を持るために備えましょう)

It is very important for everyone to know how to be prepared for Natural Disasters. We should learn how to protect our lives from any natural disasters from the experiences we have had, such as earthquakes, typhoon, tornados and heavy downpours.

We should also share practical tips with families to raise awareness of disaster preparedness.

How to be prepared?

Major life lines such as electricity, phone or water may be unavailable and major roads may be destroyed. It will be difficult to depend solely on the government or firefighting crews under these circumstances. For this reason, we are required to raise awareness of preparedness for any natural disasters and we should help each other and ourselves in case of emergency.

It is important to know how dangerous it can be and what we can do to minimize damages caused by natural disasters.

- We should act accordingly in case of emergency . What we can do to prepare for emergencies is;
- · to have the right Natural disaster education
- to participate in the regional emergency management plan
- to know dangerous places in your neighborhood or in your house
- to receive public announcements over the radio or municipal disaster management radio communication network.
- Being prepared and planning ahead is critical

It is highly advisable to have an earthquake resistant house and furniture, and large home electrical appliances should be well placed in a safe place with security devices to prevent injuries from toppled appliances.

- We must keep at least a 3-day supply of water, food, and any other basic life necessities for our families.
 *You will need at least a one week supply of life necessities if the place you live in can be damaged badly in case of emergencies.
- You need an emergency bag in which you have valuables, flashlight, and emergency food. It is also advisable that you undertake a routine check of your emergency bag.
- · All family members should know where to evacuate to, or which route to take to get to the evacuation place, and know who to contact in case of emergencies.

Earthquake Safety Tips

We cannot predict when or where earthquakes will happen, however the emergency earthquake alert from Meteorological Agency will alert us just before the ground starts shaking strongly, and it will help us to act accordingly to protect ourselves from the shaking.

It is important to act quickly and calmly as there will only be a few seconds before the earthquake arrives after the alert sounds telling people around you that the earthquake is coming.

- ♦ If you are in a house
 - Drop down and take cover under a desk or table with some *Zabuton* or cushions on your head.
 - · Stay away from big furniture that can fall on you.
 - Stay indoors until the shaking stops and you can find a safe route to exit.
 - If a fire breaks out, you should extinguish it if possible but don't try to do it if you are far away from the fire.
- ◆ If you are in a shopping mall or any other building
- Stay away from windows, shelves and any lights that can fall on you.
- · Protect your head and hold on.
- · Follow the advice that security guards will give
- · Don't panic or rush to the exit or stairs.
- ♦ If you are in an elevator
- Hit the button for the nearest floor and get out as soon as possible.
- ♦ If you are driving
 - Drive slowly with hazard lights on to let other people know the emergency
 - Pull over to the left side of the road and wait in the car until the shaking stops. Don't stop suddenly!
 - When the shaking stops get out of the car with the automobile inspection certificate and keep the car doors unlocked.
- ♦ If you are on a bus or a train
 - Hold tight on to the strap in order not to be thrown out of the bus or train carriage.
- · Follow the advice made by conductors.
- ♦ If you are in a town
 - Stay away from any walls or vending machines that can fall on you.
- Move quickly away from any buildings, as you might be hurt by signs or broken glass falling down from buildings.
- ◆ If you are on a mountain or near a cliff
 - Go to an open area away from dangerous areas where rocks might fall or a landslide might happen.

If you are unable to get home

It is expected that public transportation will stop working in the event of large natural disaster.

People will start getting home all at once on foot, which can not only hinder any rescue activities but there will also be danger of severe injuries caused be falling objects.

It is important to be calm, ensure your security, stay in a secure place, and gather correct information in case of an emergency.

- You should not move around in case of an emergency
 - · First you should ensure the security around you
 - Stay in a secure place such as an office building or other facility
 - confirm the security of your family members through the disaster emergency message dial
- obtain information about public transportation availability and damages
- Be prepared at all times for an emergency
- · take a mobile radio or maps with you
- Keep emergency supplies at your workplace such as walking shoes, flashlight, globes, drinking water, and food
- have a plan with your family where to meet or how to ensure the security of each other in case of an emergency
- identify safe routes that lead to your house on foot or by bus
- identify convenience stores or gas station on the way home

The government will help you when you are unable to get home in an emergency

The government of nine prefectures and cities - Chiba-Pref, Saitama-Pref, Tokyo-to, Kanagawa-Pref, Yokohama-city, Kawasaki-city, Chiba-city, Saitama-city and Sagamihara-city have concluded an agreement with convenience stores, family restaurants and gas stations to help people who are unable to get home. This treaty is called "Saigaiji-Kitakusien Station" and these stores and facilities will offer you drinking water, restroom facilities, information and places for rest as much as they can in case of an emergency.

Water Damage Safety Tips

Fortunately, typhoons and locally concentrated heavy rainfall can be predicted beforehand. It is important to be prepared for these natural disasters at any time.

- ◆ Before a Typhoon is coming
- Examine your house and repair any unstable parts, and bring things that can be blown away by a typhoon into your house.
- Tape or film windows so that they cannot shatter if they break, and close the curtains to make it safer
- ♦ In case of floodwater dangers
 - Keep important things away from flood waters by putting them in higher places and identify evacuation places near your house.
- ♦ When a typhoon is coming
 - Stay away from rivers that are flooding and any other dangerous places.

The city will accept applications for nursery schools from April 2018 as follows.

Reasons for needing a nursery school

- ① Difficult to take care of the child/children at home (except when grandparents in the household can take care of the child/children)
- ② Parents' work (more than 4 hours a day and more than 16 days a month)
- ③ Mother's upcoming or recent child birth (2 months before and / or after delivery)
- ④ Parents' illness or trouble
- ⑤ Relative's care / nursing who is living in the household, or long hospitalization
- ⑥ Disaster restoration (restoration of fire damage, etc.)
- 7 Others (Job hunting activity, school attendance, etc.)

WHY NOT UTILIZE VARIOUS SUBSIDIES FOR ANY HOUSING IMPROVEMENTS

(住宅などの改修に関する各種補助金を活用しませんか?)

The city is granting various subsidies for improving housing. To utilize the subsidies, certain conditions must be met. An advanced application is necessary. Please ask for further details. *first come first served and we will maintain the subsidies for as long as the budget allows.

① Subsidy for home purchase expenses will be provided.

Residents who bought a house in order to live in it with their parent household or near the house of their parent household and who have moved to the city for this purpose are eligible to receive this subsidy.

Conditions and the maximum subsidy amount:

If you;

- (1) bought a house or built a new house, and the total floor area is more than 50 m², the amount of the maximum subsidy is ¥400,000.
- (2) added floor area to your house more than 30m², the amount of the maximum subsidy is ¥300,000.
- (3) reformed your house and it cost more than \(\frac{4}{2}00,000\),

The amount of the maximum subsidy is \\$100,000.

*another ¥100,000 will be added if you have children of junior high-school age or younger.

② Partial subsidy for housing reform expenses

Subsidies will be granted for partial expenses if the reform work is done by an inner city constructor. (The head office of the constructor has to be located in the city or it should be an individual constructor.)

Condition and the maximum subsidy amount:

We will subsidize 10% of the total of the targeted expenses, which has to be more than \(\frac{2}{2}00,000.\)

③ Partial subsidy for analysis of asbestos and cost for its removal

"Asbestos spray materials" were possibly applied to steel frames or reinforced concrete structures built between 1955 and 1988.

Target structures for this survey and analysis:

Any structures that have possibly been sprayed with asbestos.

The maximum subsidy amount: ¥250,000

*Please ask *Kenchiku Takuchi-ka* or Building Land and Guidance Section when it comes to removal work and its maximum subsidy amount when the analysis survey confirms the presence of asbestos.

4 Diagnosis for housing earthquake-resistance and partial subsidy for improvement expenses

Partial subsidies for the cost of earthquake resistance and its improvement are available for detached housing and condominiums constructed before May 1981.

Condition and the maximum subsidy amount:

- ¥70,000 for detached house earthquake resistance diagnosis and ¥500,000 for its improvement work.
- ¥1,000,000 for condominium earthquake resistance diagnosis.

Free Consultations regarding managing apartments will be available

① Advisers for the management of an apartment building will be dispatched

If you have any issues regarding the management of an apartment, you can consult on the issues with advisers dispatched from the organization of Chiba prefecture apartment management.

You can ask issues like management or operation.

Fee for dispatching advisers: free (twice a year for one management association)

② Consultation for household renovation

You can consult with the city staff specializing in renovation

LET'S TAKE PREVENTIVE SPECIFIC HEALTH CHECK-UPS FOR LIFESTYLE RELATED DISEASES

せいかつしゅうかんびょう よぼう (生活習慣病を予防しましょう)

Shiroi City will conduct a specific health check-up for the Shiroi citizens' aged over forty years old who are insured. This check-up is mainly aimed at the prevention of lifestyle related diseases, such as diabetes, high blood pressure, and so on. The city recommends health check-ups focusing on metabolic syndrome.

Lifestyle related diseases proceed without any symptoms in the early stages, and when you notice some symptoms it may have already developed into a serious situation. You will see if you are prone to metabolic syndrome or not by the size of your waistline, blood pressure and blood test. Let's try to take a check-up once a year and see how your health condition is, and improve your living habits.

Specific health check-up this year will be held as follows.

Date & place: See table 1 below.

Eligible participants: 40 years old and over, the insured through the city's health insurance

Things to bring: The insured certificate for city's health insurance, questionnaire, slippers (not necessary at Health and Welfare Center)

Those eligible have already received a questionnaire, sent from the city by early June.

*Those who have already taken the check-up in June or July, or who received Health check-up subsidy, cannot take the check-up.

Check-up is free of charge

◆ Those who need to apply

Those who joined the city's health insurance after May 2017 and who didn't receive the questionnaire, should apply at *Hoken Nenkin-ka* or Health and Pension Section.

♦ Those who take a health check-up at their place of work

Those who take a similar health check-up at their place of work don't need to take the city's check-up. Please submit a copy of the health check-up results and the completed questionnaire sent from the city to Insurance and Pension Section. City will send the guidance for minimizing your metabolic risk factors.
