Holiday of September - 9/18 *Keirou no Hi* (Respect for the Aged Day) The third Monday of September is assigned to Respect for the Aged Day. Its purpose is to honor the elderlies who had contributed to the society and to celebrate their long life. Even though the original concept was started from a small village, later it was included in national holidays on 1966.

PROTECT OUR LIVES FROM NATURAL DISASTERS (英書から帯を守る)

Save Our Own Lives during Any Natural Disasters.

It is very important for everyone to know how to be prepared for natural disasters, such as earthquakes, typhoon, tornados and heavy downpours, which no one can predict when and where they will occur. September 1st is "Disaster Prevention Day". It is the occasion for us to promote daily awareness and to make sure of preventative measures.

Community cooperation

Major life lines such as electricity, phone or water may be unavailable and major roads may be destroyed. It will be difficult to depend solely on the government or firefighting crews under these circumstances. For this reason, we are required to raise awareness of preparedness for any natural disasters and we should help ourselves (self-help) help each other in the community (neighbor help, help each other) in case of emergency. Let's improve the way we deal with disasters.

To know

- * Learn the correct knowledge of natural disasters
- * Know dangerous places in your neighborhood and in your house
- * Receive correct information by public announcements over the radio or by the municipal disaster management radio communication network

Three kinds of evacuation announcements from the city

Please take an early action when the evacuation announcement is given from the city.

The announcements will be given by the municipal disaster management radio, Shiroi e-mail service and on the city website.

Direction to evacuate

You need to evacuate right now to the shelter

Advice to evacuate

• You need to evacuate as soon as possible

Prepare to evacuate / Elderly need to begin to evacuate

- Get ready to evacuate at any time.
- Elderly and those who require additional time to evacuate need to begin to evacuate

"Shiroi e-mail service" is available

"Shiroi e-mail service", which will transmit the information of disaster, a crime in the city, and municipal disaster management radio messages to your PC or mobile phone. More details are available on the city website.

Be prepared

- Have an earthquake resistant house and ensure furniture and large home electrical appliances are well
 placed in a safe place with security devices.
- You must keep at least a 3-day supply of water (3\(\ell\)per day per person), food, and any other basic life necessities for your families.
 - XYou will need at least a one week supply of life necessities if the wide area is damaged badly by a big earthquake.
- You need an emergency bag. It is also advisable that you undertake a routine check of your emergency bag.
- All family members should know where to evacuate to, or which route to take to get to the evacuation place.
- Let's take part in the disaster prevention drill

In the event of an earthquake

"The emergency earthquake alert" from Meteorological Agency will alert us just before the ground starts shaking strongly, and it will help us to act accordingly to protect ourselves from the shaking. It is important to act quickly and calmly as there will only be a few seconds before the earthquake arrives after the alert sounds telling people around you that the earthquake is coming

◆ If you are in a house

- * Protect your head with cushions, keep away from large furniture and hide under a solid desk. Secure an evacuation route, and don't rush outside.
- * If a fire breaks out, you should extinguish it if possible but don't try to do it if you are far away from the fire.

◆ If you are in a shopping mall or any other building

- * Stay away from windows, shelves and any hanging lights that can fall on you.
- * Protect your head and hold on.
- * Follow the advice that security guards will give
- * Don't panic or rush to the exit or stairs.

◆ If you are in an elevator

* Hit the button for the nearest floor and get out as soon as possible.

◆ If you are driving

- * Drive slowly with hazard lights on to let other people know the emergency
- * Pull over to the left side of the road and wait in the car until the shaking stops. Don't stop suddenly!
- *When the shaking stops get out of the car with the automobile inspection certificate, keep the car doors unlocked, and evacuate.

◆ If you are in a town

- * Stay away from any concrete-block walls or vending machines that can fall on you.
- * Move quickly away from any buildings, as you might be hurt by signs or broken glass falling down from buildings.

♦ If you are on a bus or a train

- * Hold tight on to the strap in order not to be thrown out of the bus or train carriage.
- *Follow the advice given by conductors.

♦ If you are on a mountain or near a cliff

* Go to an open area away from dangerous areas where rocks might fall or a landslide might happen.

In the event of typhoon or localized heavy rain

Fortunately, typhoons and locally concentrated heavy rainfall can be predicted beforehand.

It is important to be prepared for these natural disasters at any time.

When a typhoon is approaching

Stay away from rivers that are flooding and any other dangerous places.

Before a typhoon is coming

- * Examine your house and repair any unstable parts, and bring things that can be blown away by a typhoon into your house.
- * Tape or film windows so that they cannot shatter if they break, and close the curtains to make it safer
- * Keep important things away from flood waters by putting them in higher places and identify evacuation places near your house.

If you are unable to get home

It is expected that public transportation will stop working in the event of large natural disaster. People will start getting home all at once on foot, which can not only hinder any rescue activities but there will also be danger of severe injuries caused be falling objects. It is important to be calm, ensure your security, stay in a secure place, and gather correct information in case of an emergency.

You should not move around in case of an emergency

- First you should ensure the security around you
- Stay in a secure place such as an office building or other facility
- Confirm the security of your family members through the disaster emergency message dial
- Obtain information about public transportation availability and damages

Always be prepared

- Take a mobile radio or maps with you
- Keep emergency supplies at your workplace such as walking shoes, flashlight, globes, drinking water, and food
- Have a plan with your family where to meet or how to ensure the security of each other in case of an emergency
- Identify safe routes that lead to your house on foot or by bus
- Identify convenience stores or gas stations on the way home

"Saigaiji-Kitakusien Station"

The government of nine prefectures and cities – Chiba-Pref, Saitama-Pref, Tokyo-to, Kanagawa-Pref, Yokohama-city, Kawasaki-city, Chiba-city, Saitama-city and Sagamihara-city have concluded an agreement with convenience stores, family restaurants and gas stations to help people who are unable to get home. This treaty is called "Saigaiji-Kitakusien Station" and these stores and facilities will offer you drinking water, restroom facilities, information and places for rest as much as they can in case of an emergency.

November 4th (Sun), Let's participate in disaster drills (防災訓練)

Disaster drills this year will be held in "Shiroi Comprehensive Park" which has a disaster prevention function. Please prepare in the everyday life and have correct knowledge of disasters, to minimize the disaster damage. Let's participate, with families and local community people, in disaster drills.

Time: 9:30 am ~2:00 pm

Place: Shiroi Comprehensive Park

- Cooking on a cooking stove bench (*Tonjiru* cooked by Self-Defense Force will be served for free)
- Experience a large earthquake in the earthquake experience vehicle
- Drills on how to deal with disasters including the experience of manhole toilet
- Presentation and sale by the organization and industry related to the disasters (free participation)
- * Held in the light rain (some programs may be cancelled). If there's bad weather or if a disaster actually occurs, the event will be canceled.

LET'S TAKE SPECIFIC HEALTH CHECK-UP TO PREVENT GETTING OR DEVELOPPING LIFESTYLE RELATED DISEASES INTO A SERIOUS SITUATION

(生活習慣病の発症や重症化を予防するため健診を受けましょう)

Shiroi City will conduct a specific health check-up for Shiroi citizens aged over forty years old who are insured. This check-up is mainly aimed at the prevention of lifestyle related diseases, such as diabetes, high blood pressure, and so on. The city recommends a health check-up focusing on metabolic syndrome.

Lifestyle related diseases proceed without any symptoms in the early stages, and when you notice some symptoms it may have already developed into a serious situation. If you see your health condition early, you can change your eating habits and prevent getting lifestyle related diseases. Let's try to take a check-up once a year and see how your health condition is, and improve your living habits.

*Those who have already taken a check-up in June or July, or received Health check-up subsidy, cannot take the check-up.

Date & place: See table 1 below.

Eligible participants: 40 years old and over, the insured through the city's health insurance

Things to bring: The insured certificate for city's health insurance, questionnaire (already sent in early June), slippers (not necessary at Health and Welfare Center)

Those who joined city's health insurance after May 2018 and who didn't receive the questionnaire, should apply at *Hoken Nenkin-ka* or Insurance and Pension Section.

◆ Those who take health check-up at the working place

Those who take the similar health check-up at the working place don't need to take the city's check-up.

Please submit the copy of the health check-up result and a questionnaire sent from the city to Insurance and Pension Section. City will send the guidance for minimizing lifestyle related diseases risk factors.

Latter Seniors' health check-up available as well on the same date

Please apply for the latter seniors' health check-up for those who have latter seniors' health insurance card to Health Section, as many of those have already had the medical treatment of the diseases in the clinic or hospital.

City has already sent a questionnaire in the early June to those who have taken city's health check-up for the past two years and to those who apply this year for the first time.

* Those who have received subsidy for health check-up cannot take it.

Lung cancer, tuberculosis, hepatitis virus check-ups

Also available are chest X-ray check-ups for lung cancer and tuberculosis, and blood check-ups for hepatitis virus type B, type C for those who are 40 years and older, and have never taken the check-up before. Please bring the questionnaire sent from the city in June. Those who have the check-up for the first time, need to apply to *Kenko-ka* (Health Section).

The allowances for disabled persons and their families are to be paid

(障がいのある人やその家族などに手当を支給)

To continue receiving each allowance, recipients need to submit a "Regular income report" by Sep. 11th (Tue). ** There is a limit according to the income of a recipient, a spouse, and support required person in each allowance.

Special Disabled Person allowance

Allowance for those who are aged 20 years and older, and have a serious disability, needing special care and support in daily life.

Eligible

- Those who have a physical disability note grade 1 and 2, and have duplicate disabilities.
- Those who have supporting notebook ⊗-1. A part of those who have supporting notebook ⊗-2
- Those who have serious mental illness, blood vessel disease, lever disease

Disabled Children Welfare allowance

Allowance for those who are under 20 years old and have a serious disability needing special care and support in daily life.

Eligible

- A part of those who have physical disability note grade 1 and 2
- Those who have supporting notebook @
- Those who have especially serious mental illness, blood vessel disease, lever disease

Special Children Support allowance

Allowance for parents who support children with disabilities (under 20 years old) Eligible

- Parents of children who have physical disability note grade 1, 2 and 3 (partially)
- Parents of children who have supporting notebook @ and A
- Parents of children who have supporting notebook B (partially)
- Parents of children who have serious mental illness, blood vessel disease, lever disease
