SYMPATHY MONEY WHICH SHIROI CITY HAS GIVEN TO PATIENTS SUFFERING FROM INCURABLE DISEASES WILL BE DISCONTINUED AS OF SEPTEMBER 30 (FRIDAY)

(白井市難病疾患者見舞金は9月30日(金)で廃止となります)

Shiroi city has been giving a gift of money as sympathy for those patients suffering specific incurable diseases. By enforcement of "the Law for medical treatment, etc. for patients with incurable diseases", the ratios for medical expenses burden has reduced from 30% to 20%.

With the consideration of various circumstance changes around incurable diseases, it has been decided that as of Friday, 30 September 2016 "the system for sympathy money given evenly to those patients" will be discontinued. Your kind understanding and cooperation are highly appreciated.

Please make a quick application for sympathy money for FY2016, if you haven't done so yet.

* Those who have been receiving it, don't need to make an application.

Applicable persons:

Those who correspond to one of the following and whose valid term is Friday, September 30

- ① Persons who have a qualified certificate on the designated medical expense system (designated incurable disease)
- 2 Persons who have a qualified certificate for a child who is chronic and on the designated medical expense system
- 3 Persons who have a qualified certificate for congenital blood coagulating factor disorder
- * 1 & 2 above are the only patients suffering incurable disease and registered on this system since Friday, December 31, 2014. For more details, you are requested to inquire.

Monthly payment amount: 2,500 yen

Necessary things for application:

Qualified certificate valid on Friday, September 30, 2016, a copy of his/her own bankbook and Inkan or seal.

Don't Forget Tax Payment (納付を忘れずに)

Wednesday, August 31 is the deadline for the following city taxes, etc.

- City and prefectural tax (2nd term)
- National health insurance tax (2nd term)
- Public nursing care insurance premium (2nd term)
- Public medical care insurance premium for the elderly above 75 years (2nd term)

Let's pay the city taxes, etc. within the due date (If not paid, money in arrears will be imposed).

An automatic payment withdrawn from your bank account is a convenient way to pay due taxes. City taxes etc. may also be paid at convenience stores, if it is within the due time (except public medical care insurance for the elderly).

FOR FATHER/CHILD OR MOTHER/CHILD FAMILY (文子・母子家庭のみなさんへ)

The city is providing a child allowance or a medical expense subsidy to a parent or custodian of his/her child who is less than eighteen years old; or a child with a certain degree of disability who is less than twenty years old at the time of March 31, 2017, and who corresponds to one of the following. If you meet one of the criteria below, please make an application.

- · After parents have divorced, and a child is not living together with their father or mother.
- · A child whose father or mother has died.
- · A child whose father or mother is heavily disabled (first class grade suffering or so on the National Pension).
- · A child whose father or mother's life or death is unknown.
- · A child who is abandoned by a father or mother for more than one year.
- · A child whose father or mother is on probation.
- · A child whose father or mother is on detention by law for more than one year.
- · A mother who gave a birth without marriage.
- · And a child whose birth history is unknown.

Application for Approval of Child Support Allowance

Please apply to *Kosodate Shien-ka* or Childrearing Support Section for a new child rearing allowance this year, for those who could not get the allowance because of an income restriction in FY 2015.

When approval is given after the examination, an allowance will be provided from the month after the application.

*For those who were suspended for FY2015 application, there is no need for approval, because the city will send a Present Status Report for FY2016 at the beginning of August 2016.

[Things necessary to apply]

A family register, a resident's card (all family members in the same house), for those who moved in after January 2, 2016, FY2016's income certificate, applicant's banking book, and Inkan or Seal.

* Depending on the household situation, additional papers (documentation) may be required.

From August 1, the Additional Amount for Child Support Allowance will Change

"Child Support Allowance Law" changed on August 1. The allowance for the second and third children's additional amount changed as follows from August 1.

Subsidy for Medical Expenses, etc. to One Parent Family, etc.

When a mother/child family or a father/child family consult a doctor at hospital, etc. (inpatient, outpatient, medicine, etc.), a portion of insurance paid by own expense will be subsidized.

[Things necessary to apply]

Health insurance card, a family register, a resident's card (all family members in the same house), for those who moved in after January 2, 2016, FY2016's income certificate, Inkan or Seal, and an application for child raising (only for one parent if due to divorce).

*Those who apply for a child rearing allowance, may omit all documents except a health insurance card.

Don't forget submission for "Present Status Report for Child Support Allowance and One Parent Medical Expenses Subsidy"

Shiroi city will mail at the beginning of August a "Present Status Report" to those who are currently receiving subsidies. This notice is the document provided as of August 1 every year in order for the city to confirm whether or not a recipient of the allowance is still eligible.

As it is necessary for the "Present Status Report" to be confirmed in the presence of recipients, it will only be handled at the office desk. If you don't submit your report, the allowance will not be provided in August and afterwards.

Deadline: Wednesday August 31.

Farmers harvest vegetables early in the morning, so the selling time may be different each time. Please check the schedule on the Shiroi bulletin calendar on the 1st of every month. The market will open in the event of light rain, and will be canceled in bad weather, or changed when another event is being held. Closed on year end and New Year Days.

Periodical vaccination for hepatitis type B (B型觧炎予防接種が定期接種となります)

From October 1st (Sat), the hepatitis type B vaccination will be given periodically for free, and the 3-time vaccination can be given to children until they become 1 year old.

Those who are to be given the vaccination will receive a preliminary examination card by the time they become 2 months old (born from April to June, the card will be sent in August).

Eligibility: Babies under 1 year old (born after April 1st, 2016)

* If you receive the vaccination before the periodical vaccination starts, it is optional (pay your own expenses)

Vaccination time: up to 1 year old (standard time is from 2 months to 8 months old)

Number of times of vaccination: 3 times (standard vaccination, 1st time at 2 months old, 2nd time: after 27 or more days after the 1st time vaccination, 3rd time: after 139 or more days after the 1st time vaccination).

Partial subsidy for education loan interest (教育ローン利用者に利字の一節を補助)

Shiroi city partially subsidizes the costs of education loan interest.

- All members of the family have paid city tax.
- Those who have an education loan at the branch office in Shiroi city of Japan Policy Finance Corporation, Chiba Bank, Chiba Kogyo Bank, Keiyo Bank, or Chiba Credit Corporation.

Subsidy period: from the next month of the subsidy admission date until the school course is completed.
