ORIGINAL BUDGET DRAFT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 (平成30年度当初予算案)

TO REALIZE "Exciting and Full of Green Lively City"

The sum of the general account, five special accounts, and water supply account represents the FY2018 budget draft with the total amount of 34,046,536 thousand yen (a 2.3% decrease from the previous year) and has been submitted to the city assembly.

The FY2018 is the middle year of the Fifth Comprehensive Plan, and Principal thoroughly the ascertain progress of the business plan towards the realization of the city's future image of "Exciting and Full of Green Lively City". We organized the budget by looking towards the future and attention paying to promotion of sustainable administrative management.

On expenditure budget of general account for the FY 2018 budget, the per capita calculation is 329,162 yen, its usage by purpose is as shown in the above figure. 141,237 yen is covered by city tax, and 187,925 yen, the remaining amount, is managed and operated by the state and prefectural subsidies, loans, and city's savings (financial adjustment fund).

App's Function: The app simply explains information required for living regarding "Status of Residence," "Living," "Education," "Medical Care," etc. (17 items) in 15 languages, English, Chinese, Korean/North-Korean, Spanish, Portuguese, Tagalog, Vietnamese, Indonesian, Thai, Myanmar, German, French, Russian, Japanese (with furigana), and Easy Japanese.

COLLECTIVE RABIES VACCINATION (養育 大阪 大阪 の 集合 予防注射)

Shiroi city will conduct a collective rabies vaccination for dogs. To protect your family please get your dog vaccinated either via collective vaccination or at a veterinary hospital.

Dogs 91 days and older are required to get a rabies shot once a year. Places where the rabies shot will be given are shown as follows. **Shots may be given at any of these places.

If a "weather alert" is announced in Shiroi area at 7:00 am, the vaccination will be cancelled and will be given on an alternate day.

Please contact *Kankyo-ka* (Environment Section) to check when the weather is bad. Cancellation of the vaccination will be announced by emergency radio.

- ** The reserve day is 29 (national holiday) 9:30 am ~ 12:00 pm at City Office. (If the vaccination is given on the scheduled day, there will not be a reserve day)
- ◆ For registered dogs

Things to bring: Notice post card for collective vaccination, a questionnaire and a towel

Fill in the questionnaire on the notice post card beforehand.

Charge: ¥ 3,500 (vaccination, certification delivery charge)

For non-registered dogs
Things to bring: a towel

Charge: ¥ 6,500 (vaccination, certification delivery charge, registration charge)

If the dog meets one of \bigcirc \sim \bigcirc conditions, it cannot have the rabies vaccination.

- ① You moved to Shiroi city and have not changed the dog's registration.
- ② The dog has had another vaccination within the past month.
- ③ The dog has previously had a bad reaction after the vaccination.
- ④ The dog is in rut, pregnant, milking puppies, or under 91 days old.
- ⑤ You cannot hold the dog when it gets the vaccination.

INFORMATION FROM INSURANCE AND PENSION SECTION (保険年金課からのお知らせ) National Health Insurance System will change in April

National Health Insurance or "Kokuho" is the system in which subscribers share the expenses so that they can access medical care without worries when they become ill or get injured.

Municipalities administered Kokuho until FY2017. But Chiba Prefecture will become the main responsible body of Kokuho operations from April 1, 2018. Chiba Prefecture will aim to stabilize the system in the main operating role of the National Health Insurance, maintain stable financial operation, and secure efficient projects.

What will change? Qualification

Even if you move to other municipalities within Chiba Prefecture, you will not lose your qualification and will not be required to qualify again. Then if you fall under the high-cost medical care expense benefits multiple times, the new municipality will cover all of the benefits you fall under.

*Note: You are still required to obtain a health insurance card for your new address.

- ◆ What won't change after the system change
 - -Assessment and collection of National Health Insurance tax.
 - -National Health insurance subscribe/withdrawal notification.
 - -Issuance of National Health Insurance cards.
 - -Submission of applications for benefits and other items.
 - Municipalities will continue these functions and services.
 - Municipalities will give a consultation service as they have before.
- ♦ No action is necessary because of this change in the system.

You will be able to use your current National Health Insurance card April 1, 2018.

National Pension will change in April

From April 2018 until March 2019, the premium for the National Pension Insurance will be 16,340 yen per month. The premium statements delivered from Nihon Nenkin Kiko or Japan Pension Organization may be paid at a Post Office or convenience store. Credit card or bank account transfers can also be used.

If your income is not enough to pay the premium, there is a system to which you can make an application for exemption or to postpone the premium.

National Pension Premium Exemption System for Students' payment

All people who live in Japan and who are more than 20 years old are supposed to join the National Pension and pay its premium. With consideration of students generally having a small income, there is an exemption system for students' payment.

According to School Education Laws, students studying at university, graduate school, junior college, high school, advanced special school, vocational school, various schools (more than one year course of study), or a part of Japanese branch school of foreign university, if their income in the previous year was less than $\{1,180,000 \text{ yen} + \text{ (the number of dependent} \times 380,000 \text{ yen}).}$

Exemption of students' payment period is from April to March of the following year, and you need to apply for an exemption every year.

If you were exempt from payment in the previous year and will continue to study in 2018, you will receive a post card with an application form for exemption of students' payment.

When you apply, a student ID card, a student registration certificate, that proves you study at the school in 2018, is necessary. When someone else applies, bring the family seal (*Inkan*).

Please cooperate in making "List of Names for the Refugee Support Action"

(避難行動要支援者名簿の作哉にご協うを)

The city makes "List of Names for the Refugee Support Action" by the Disaster Relief Act. This is the list of names of those persons who, due to age or disability, need help in the event of a disaster.

In March, the city added new people to the list and sent "Application and confirmation forms" to persons who need the city's support in the event of disaster.

By submitting a consent form to the city, such citizens and supporting staff can share and understand the information usually. In the event of a disaster, those who have registered for support, will be supported by staff from all communities, residents' associations, volunteer disaster organizations, social welfare councils, district welfare commissioners, fire stations, police stations etc.

Conditions for needed support:

Citizens who live at home and meet one of the following;

- ① All family members are aged 70 years or over (single people are also included)
- ② Holder of the physically handicapped book ($1^{st} \sim 2^{nd}$ class of visual impairment, auditory impairment, upper limbs functional disorder, $1^{st} \sim 3^{rd}$ class of lower limbs/ trunk functional disorder, and $1^{st} \sim 2^{nd}$ class of other impairment)
- ③ Holder of Nursing Care book ⑤ or A
- ④ Holder of the 1st ~2nd psychiatric disease book by a health and welfare office
- ⑤ Person who has been designated at nursing care of the 3rd degree or higher
- 6 Other than the above, persons who need help
 - $ilde{\times}$ The city has some of the names on its roll which correspond to the above $ilde{\mathbb{Q}} \sim ilde{\mathbb{Q}}$

Persons who identify with condition **(6)** need to apply for the city's registration on the roll.

How to apply and register

Complete the necessary items in the "Application and consent on refugee support registration for Shiroi city's disaster action" form, and use the enclosed return envelope or submit it to Kiki Kanri-ka (Crisis Management Section). The 2018 fiscal year's checkups for citizens will be conducted as per the table below.

From this year, prostate cancer checkups for men who are over 50 years old and even-numbered age. Stomach cancer checkup used to end in June until last year, but this year it will be given for 2 days in November.

The best way to find diseases early is to take periodic checkups. Those who retired and have no chance to get checkups, have never had a checkup, or have not had a checkup for a long time, please take advantage of this opportunity.

This includes cancer checkups and checkups for seniors over 75 years old.

Application Date and Method

◆ Application to each community center by the deadline: March 16 (Fri)∼April 15 (Sun) Application forms must be completed with all necessary items and posted into the "collection box". Application forms and the collection box are located in Health and Welfare Center, Nishi-shiroi Fukugo, Fuji, Sakuradai, Shiroi Ekimae, Komin, and Shiroi Community Center

◆ Application through "Chiba Electronic Application Service"

You may use your PC or cell phone to directly apply by "Chiba Electronic Service". In this case the deadline is May 9 (Fri)~Nov.30 (Fri)

* Applications by QR cord (from a smart phone or cell phone) are also available.

Notice for Applications

As Shiroi city has checkup records for FY 2016 and 2017, if you want to take the same checkup items in 2018, you don't need to apply. However, when you would like different checkups from the previous one, you are requested to apply for the new checkup(s).

Corresponding ages are different for each item. Be careful when completing the application form. Questionnaire forms may not be delivered if you apply for an incorrect item.

Persons corresponding to the following conditions are not able to take a checkup:

- Persons who are under treatment or have subjective symptoms corresponding to the above items
- Persons who are to take a thorough medical checkup or similar checkup at their workplace in FY2018
- Persons who are or are expecting to be pregnant

Exemption of Checkup Fees

Persons who correspond to one of the conditions below will be exempt from checkup expenses

- ① Person who belongs to a livelihood assistance family
- ② Person who belongs to a resident's tax exempted family
- ③ Holder of a senior citizens' medical certificate (65 ~ 69 years old)
- ④ Person who is 70 years or older
- * Persons who correspond to ① or ② above and desire an exemption must apply to Kenko-ka (Health Section). For more information, contact Kenko-ka.

Persons who are Working or Child Rearing should feel comfortable about taking a Checkup

All checkup centers/clinics are open on Saturdays and Sundays.

Some medical clinics conduct individual checkups for cervical and breast cancer at the one time. Health and Welfare Center may conduct the cervical and breast cancer checkups for 40 years or older at the same time on specified days as a group checkup.

* Health and Welfare Center may take care of children for a short time during the group cervical cancer checkup only. A prior application is necessary for the child care.

FY 2018 "Welfare Taxi Ticket" will be issued (平成30年度福祉タクシー利用券を交付)

Shiroi city will issue "Welfare Taxi Ticket", partially subsiding taxi farse, for those with serious disability or seniors who need support. If you want to have the ticket please apply at the section in charge.

Issue period: March 26 (Mon) ~ (except Sat., Sun. and national holidays)

* The ticket use period is from April 1 (Sun), 2018 ~ March 31 (Sun), 2019

Eligible: Persons who meet the conditions below

- Holder of the physically handicapped book ($1^{\text{st}} \sim 2^{\text{nd}}$ class of visual impairment, lower limbs functional disorder, 3^{rd} class and over of trunk functional disorder)
- Holder of the 1st class psychiatric disease book by a health and welfare office
- Persons of 65 years and above who have been designated at nursing care 2nd ~ 5th degree

Things to bring: Physically handicapped book, Nursing care book, or Nursing care insurance book

In order to promote global warming countermeasures at home, we will grant subsidies to people installing residential energy-saving facilities from April 1, 2018, Sunday to February 28, 2019, Thursday. Grant of the subsidies will end as soon as the budget runs out.

- •has an address in the city
- •doesn't fail to pay the city tax
- •bears the installation cost, thereby owning the facility

The city will grant subsidies when conducting construction to switch either your single disposal septic tank or dipping up tank (*kumitori benjo*) to merged disposal septic tank.

Application period is from the beginning of April to December 28, 2018, Friday. However, acceptance of applications may be terminated even within the given period if we will subsidize within the budget range.

When acceptance of applications has been terminated, please apply in the following fiscal year or later. Subsidies are not provided in the following cases.

- The area is sewerage approved.
- Construction has started or been completed before the grant decision.
- The building itself is not built for living (office and the like).
- Persons who are delinquent in paying city tax.

Subsidy for Thyroid Echocardiography and Whole Body Counter - Radiation Exposure

こうじょうせん けんき (甲状腺エコー検査、ホールボディカウンタ測定費用の一部助成)

To reduce anxiety about the initial exposure of radioactive material accompanying Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant accident, the government will subsidize payment for thyroid echocardiography / whole body counter.

Thyroid Echocardiography

[Target] People who were born between April 2, 1992 and April 1, 2011, and a registered Shiroi citizen on the day of the accident.

[Subsidy Amount] half of examination expense (maximum of ¥3,000)

In the case of difficulty for infants and toddlers taking the test, guardians can take it on their behalf instead.
