EXTRAORDINARY WELFARE ALLOWANCE TO BE SUBSIDIED FOR FY 2015

(平成27年度臨時福祉給付金のお知らせ)

~ Application date: Tuesday, July 21 through Friday, October 30 ~

In order to relieve the financial burden due to the increase of consumption tax in 2014, low income recipients will get a subsidy of "the extraordinary welfare allowance" for one year from October 2015, for the same amount as last year.

Applicable persons: People whose resident tax is not imposed in FY 2015

* Dependents of a resident tax payer and recipients of public assistance are excluded.

Allowance: 6,000 yen per person (this fiscal year there is no additional allowance for pension recipients).

Date of payment: Thursday, October 1.

* To receive payment on October 1, an application is necessary by Friday, September 11

♦ Procedure

Term of application date: Tuesday, July 21 ~ Friday, October 30 (without fail)

Send application forms to: The municipality, etc. of the citizen's registration as of January 1, 2015.

Application method: Apply by postal mail with the application form and attached document.

Application forms were enclosed on Friday, July 17 together with a notice stating "tax-free" to eligible families. Complete the form and post it.

◆ **Notice**: An application form may not necessarily be sent to all applicable families due to the state of dependents. In other cases, even if an application form is sent, a subsidy may not be granted following examination.

~PEACE MOVIE COMING ON SCREEN~(BY LEADING ACTRESS, SAYURI YOSHINAGA)

"Aa, Himeyuri no Tou (Monument to the Girl's Corps)" 平和映画上映会(吉永小百合主演)「あゝ、ひめゆりの塔」

On Saturday, August 15, the 70th year anniversary of the end of World War II, a movie gathering will be held to think about the importance of peace.

Date: Saturday, August 15th, at 2 p.m. (The venue opens at 1:30 p.m.)

The movie, which was first put on a screen in 1968, is a Japanese black and white film, lasting two hours and five minutes

Place: Shiroi Culture Hall, Nashi-bo large hall

Audience: General (Free participation)

Outline: In 1943, Japan entered a disadvantageous situation in the Pacific War, as U.S. forces made a reverse attack, but Okinawa people didn't feel seriously about the war.

In 1944, the war situation worsened, and Okinawa islands were declared a war state of emergency. The girl students were mobilized as extraordinary nurses, and boy students as a blood-and-iron loyalty force for the Emperor. As U.S. military landed ashore, severe battles continued, and the girls "Red star lily corps", consisting of Okinawa normal (teacher's) girl school students, were forced into painful corners mentally and physically by the cruel war.

This movie describes the story of the tragic fate for the "red star lily corps", in the front line battle, Okinawa.
