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# ORIGINAL BUDGET DRAFT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 (平成27年度当初予算案)

### TO REALIZE "A SAFE & HEALTHY SHIROI CITY BUILT UP WITH CITIZENS"

The FY2015 budget draft, compiled with the total amount of 29,935,840 thousand yen (1.4% increase over the last year), represents the sum of the general account, five special accounts and the water supply account. This draft has been submitted to the city assembly.

General Account: Total amount of revenue: 16,920,000 thousand yen

#### Breakdown

City tax: Taxes from residents, real estate, city planning, etc. 8,591,840 thousand yen (50.8%)

City bond: Long term loan from the state, banks, etc. 1,295,310 thousand yen (7.7%)

State expenditure: Subsidy from the state, etc. 2,060,950 thousand yen (12.2%)

Local grant tax: The state provides grants to increase income balance among municipalities (from five national taxes, including income tax etc.) 798,000 thousand yen (4.7%)

Prefectural expenditure: Subsidy, etc. from Chiba prefecture 969,850 thousand yen (5.7%)

Local consumption tax subsidy: A portion of consumption tax to be given by the prefecture 908,000 thousand yen (5.4%)

Money transferred: A portion of the city's fund to be put into the general account 860,650 thousand yen (5.1%)

Others: Miscellaneous income, fees, charges, amounts carried over, etc. 1,435,400 thousand yen (8.5%)

### Total amount of expenditure: 16,920,000 thousand yen

#### Breakdown

Public welfare: Welfare expenses for the aged and children, etc. 5,788,770 thousand yen (34.2%)

Education: Expenses for schools and social education, etc. 1,901,320 thousand yen (11.2%)

General Affairs: PR (public relations), planning, traffic safety, whole city's general expenses 2,387,020 thousand yen (14.1%)

Public Hygiene: Health check-ups, garbage disposal, etc. 1,623,750 thousand yen (9.6%)

City bond: Repayment of city's loan for principal and interest. 1,345,130 thousand yen (7.9%)

Firefighting: Expenses for management of fire stations and activity of firefighting groups 1,126,240 thousand yen (6.7%)

Miscellaneous: Expenses for public enterprises and the special accounts 1,194,170 thousand yen (7.1%)

Others: Expenses for public works, the city assembly, commerce & industry, agriculture & fisheries, etc. 1,553,590 thousand yen (9.2%)

The FY2015 budget was compiled with the steady achievement of the last fiscal year of the Fourth Comprehensive Principle Plan which aims to realize "a safe & healthy Shiroi city built up with citizens' participation".

The budget for the general account includes an implementation design for development of the city hall, reconstruction of Ikenokami day-care center for school children, and promotion of regional plans for disaster prevention, etc.

Details of total revenue and expenditure for the general account of 16,920,000 thousand yen are shown above.

When the city budget is calculated into per capita, it becomes 269,594 yen and its breakdown is as follows. 136,898 yen (\*1) out of 269,594 yen (\*2) is covered by the city tax, and the remaining 132,696 yen is managed by subsidies from the state and prefecture, and loan, withdrawal of city's saving (financial adjustment fund).

# CURRENT STATUS OF RADIATION VALUE IN THE CITY AND FUTURE

RADIOACTIVE MEASURES (市内の放射線量の状況と今後の放射線対策)

### City's Implementation plan for removal of radioactive contamination

Shiroi city has been conducting its own measures for citizens' safety and relief from radioactive effects since the accident of Fukushima No. 1 nuclear power plant, Tokyo Electric Power Co.

<sup>&</sup>quot;Capital": Construction field. The large FY2015 budget amount is due to the inclusion of a trust fund for implementing design changes for the water supply plant.

The "Special law for measures against the radioactive substance contamination" was enacted in December 2011. As the city was designated as an important survey district for radioactive contamination, it developed "Shiroi city's implementation plan for removal of contamination" in April 2012, and has tackled concrete and planned measures.

This plan, as a basic policy, aimed to ensure a radiation value of less than 1 milli-sievert per year, and less than 0.23 micro-sievert ( $\mu$  Sv) per hour in average space radiation values, and the city has subsequently removed radioactive contamination from public facilities and housing.

### Tackling removal of radioactive contamination so far

According to "the city's implementation plan for decontamination", 84 public facilities and 36 kilometers of school roads were originally identified for removal of radiation. From those identified, and following detailed surveying, decontamination of 54 public facilities and 570 meters of the school roads were deemed necessary, and decontamination of these areas was finished at the end of FY 2012. After 2013, the city decontaminated partial districts of high radiation value and additional places of increasing radiation as required.

From August 2012, 243 detached homes were decontaminated from the residents' required 559 homes.

### Status of radiation value in the city

142 public facilities were periodically surveyed four times a year from July 2014, and the surveyed value remained less than 0.23 micro-sievert per hour at all of the surveyed locations.

All of the 192 surveyed locations along roadsides valued less than 0.23 micro-sievert per hour in the survey in June and July 2014. This figure decreased by approximately half its value (on average) from the survey conducted in January/February 2012. The target plans for decontamination have been achieved over all city areas.

In the fiscal year of 2013, teachers and school staff who worked or lived in four districts (Sakuradai Junior High School (east zone), Shimizuguchi nursery school (west), Ikenokami Elementary School (south), Shiroi Daini Elementary School (north)), surveyed "24-hour integrating radiation exposure value". At that time, the annual estimated values were less than  $0.507 \sim 0.778$  milli-sievert throughout the year, which is less than 1 milli-sievert annually.

### **Future radioactive measures**

The "Shiroi city's implementation plan for decontamination" has now delivered on its purpose of the basic policy. Therefore, implementation will finish at the end of March 2015 as scheduled.

A partial high value of space radiation, however, may be found in the future. Therefore, a periodical survey will continue in fiscal year 2015, and partial decontamination will be conducted as needed.

In addition, surveys for detached homes upon residents' request, food materials for school lunch in elementary and junior high schools, city's agriculture products, and residents' brought-in food; and subsidies for medical expenses for check-ups by a whole-of-body counter instrument will continue as usual.

Removed waste soils from the decontamination works of the detached homes are now placed in designated areas. They will continue to be stored in the same place until the government decides on a disposal standard for the soil, enabling the city to then dispose of the soil appropriately.

- **3 Availability during emergency situations** When a disaster or a power failure occurs, the website will continue to be available, because it will be operated by the data center. Even if there is a high level of traffic to the website, the updated home page will be available.

# Rules for dealing with disasters (災害発生時の心得)

### ~ Don't move around unnecessary, and behave calmly ~

When a large scale disaster occurs while you are away from home, for example, if you are in the office, school or other place, returning home may be difficult due to the cessation of public transportation.

Moreover, when people return home simultaneously, they may disrupt emergency rescue activities and/or injure themselves from resulting fires or falling objects from buildings along roads.

### "Don't start moving around unnecessarily" when a disaster occurs

- At first, secure your own safety.
- Remain in a safe place, such as your office or evacuation facility.
- Secure the safety of your family and home through the message board for disaster.
- Access information relating to traffic conditions and damage to buildings and infrastructure.

### ♦ Everyday preparation for disasters

- Bring a portable radio and a map with you.
- Have a pair of comfortable sneakers, a flash light, a pair of gloves, drinking water, food, etc in your workplace.
- Discuss in advance with your family about the way to secure your family's safety and an agreed meeting place, etc.
- Make sure that you have the known route for returning home on foot or by bus.
- Make sure that you know the location of the convenience stores or gas stations on your way back home.

Nine prefectures and cities (Tokyo, Kanagawa Pref. Chiba Pref. Saitama Pref. Yokohama City, Kawasaki City, Sagamihara City, Chiba City, Saitama City) have made agreements of "Support for returning pedestrians" with convenience stores and gas stations.

During a disaster, take advantage of the opportunity for possible tap water, rest room facilities, and traffic information at convenience stores when returning home on foot.

# Small Home Appliances Collection in the Base Box will start from February 20th (Fri), 2015

(2月20日から使用済み小型家電の拠点回収を始めます)

Small home appliances such as home telephones, digital cameras, etc., which have previously been collected as non-combustible waste, will now be collected via collection boxes placed at each of the community centers and at the city hall for recycling.

Small home appliances, 15 cm long and 30 cm wide and smaller, that can be placed in the collection box, can be collected. When an appliance is too big to place in a collection box, place it with non-combustible waste as in the past. More details about the collection boxes is available on the city website and by a flier available at community centers.

Mobile phone, PHS, personal computer, telephone, facsimile, radio, digital camera, video camera, film camera, visual equipment (DVD recorder, etc.), flash light, hard disc memories, USB memories, electric books, small games, electric dictionary, electric calculator, electric thermometer, tonometer, hair dryer, electric razor, audio equipment (digital audio player, CD player), clock, car equipment (car navigation, car stereo), remote-control, AC adapter, cable and so on.

Before putting appliances in the box, eliminate all personal information and data.

 Remove batteries and take them out following the rules.
