

Hi, Consumer Affairs Center No. 246 (Feb. 15, '20 issue) Will it be really cheaper!? Contract of optical line (はい消費生活センターです

No. 246 本当に安くなる!? 光回線の契約)

Q: A man called me and introduced himself as a staff member of major telecom company. He said their telephone fee would be cheaper and I signed a contract as he advised. Actually, the fee is higher than before. Can I cancel the contract? (Male in 70s)

A: This case is of a contract with a so-called optical collaboration (hereinafter called optical collab) where a major telecom company wholesales their optical line service to a business operator(s) and the business operator offer the optical line to individuals adding their optional services, etc.

There is no cooling off system for optical line services but you can cancel the contract within 8 days from the day that you received the contract or from when the line was connected based on the initial stage contract cancellation system. Instead of a cooling off system, you need to pay a service fee, any instalment costs and handling charges in this case.

Even in cases where you cannot cancel the contract according to the initial stage contract cancellation system, you may be able to negotiate a cancellation if there was problem in the sales method.

Sales in optical collab is done by agents for a business operator. They stress merits only such as, "cheaper than your present contract" and there are so many cases of trouble such as, the fee was actually higher because unnecessary option(s) wasere added or you cannot contact the agent after signing the contract. There are cases that you have to pay additional fee to cancel the present contract. Before signing a new contract, please confirm the contents of the new contract in comparison with your present contract and how you can contact the agent. Whenever you have any doubts or troubles, please feel free to consult us.

Shiroi Union Hospital (白井組合病院)

In Japan, National Health Insurance Act was enforced in 1938. It was voluntary to take out health insurance or not and the insurance was run by each insurance union. In Shiroi a health insurance union was established in 1943 but it was virtually closed from the beginning.

After World War II, in 1947 Genshiro Ishibashi, mayor of Shiroi village and Tadayoshi Kanno who to evacuated Tokyo reorganized the union and opened a clinic run directly by the village. Medical doctors took office for internal medicine and surgery departments. Chiba Medical College (now a department of Chiba University) recommended the doctors. The clinic started to diagnose in1948 and became the core medical institution in the region.

The clinic expanded with the cooperation of towns and villages nearby and in 1949, Shiroi Union Hospital was established to succeed the clinic. It was the only hospital in Chiba prefecture managed by a single union and the second largest of its kind in Japan. In November of the same year, comprehensive health examinations were carried out with the cooperation of Chiba Medical College and medical records were made for all of the villagers. The advanced work was introduced on NHK and many people visited it for observation, we hear. In 1951, the second ward was constructed. The number of staff increased to 20 including 5 doctors and one pharmacist. The total number of beds was 46. The departments were internal medicine, pediatrics, surgery, obstetrics and gynecology, dermatology, urology and dental

It was useful for the establishment of the hospital that Ishibashi had experience of establishing and managing a clinic before the war and Tadayoshi Kanno was a lecturer at the military hospital. In 1954, Eiji village and part of Shiroi village merged and the operation of the insurance union deteriorated. At the same time, the management of health insurance by municipality became compulsory according to the revision of law. Under such circumstances, the management of health insurance was transferred to Shiroi village and the Shiroi Union Hospital became Shiroi Village National Health Hospital run by the village.

In 1968, the hospital was reorganized to Shiroi Town National Health Insurance Clinic after demolition of the old ward. Health Center was installed in 1976 and Welfare Center was installed in 1983 in the premises. Such facilities were merged to Health and Welfare Center in 2001 when the town became a city, and the clinic was closed. The old health center became Central Public Hall and the welfare center became Shiroi Children's Hall. In 2009, Shiroi Community Center was constructed using the site where the central public hall and the clinic were located.

There are few traces of the hospital remaining but the stone monument stands in front of the Shiroi Children's Hall to honor Genshiro Ishibashi who contributed greatly to the establishment of the hospital.



Rubella virus has been rampant from two years ago, centering around adults.

If a female without immunity is pregnant and infected with the virus, her embryo may have \lceil congenital rubella syndrome \rfloor which can result in hearing loss, heart disease, cataract, etc for the child. In the past year, 4 newborns were diagnosed with congenital rubella syndrome.

As a measure to prevent the disease, the city subsidizes part of the rubella vaccination cost for people who were diagnosed as low antibody titer.

Target vaccination: Injection of rubella vaccine or mix of rubella and MR (measles rubella) vaccines between September 20 (Thu), 2018 and March 31 (Tue), 2020.

Deadline for applications: Until March 31 (Tue)

Target: Citizens who falls under ① or ② below, and the result of their antibody test was negative or reserved or they had an EIA value of less than 8.0.

- ① Females who want to be pregnant and their spouses (including common-law marriage)

For the Mental Health of yourself and people around you (measures for the prevention of suicide)

In March, people feel more stress due to the changes of social status and environments in life such as removal, personnel change, advancement to the next stage of education, etc.

It is said that every person has stress and worry, and some people may have a personal crisis and think of committing suicide. Won't you think of it as a familiar problem and not turn a blind eye to it as matter of other people? In 2018, 20,031 people committed suicide in Japan. In Shiroi city, about 10 people commit suicide each year.

The government designated a week in September as suicide prevention week and March as a month to strengthen the

measures for the prevention of suicide because suicide increases after summer vacation and at the time when life changes occur due to start of working, etc. Last year, the city made a plan to reduce the rate of suicide and is carrying out comprehensive measures for that.

Here, we would like to introduce measures that you and people close to you can practice. First of all, it's important to have balanced meals and make a suitable life rhythm. It is helpful to have time for relaxation and light exercise. It also will help you to share your complaints and concerns and consult with people close to you.

What you can do for the people close to you are to 「Notice, Listen to, Connect and Watch over」 and you can help reduce the risk of suicide. Some people are unable to complain or consult in a timely manner about their mental health problems. You may notice signs of people close to you such as, "Can't sleep well", "No appetite", "Don't speak as much as before". It will help a lot to notice the unordinary signs of people close to you, to share their pains, consult with experts for them and watch over them saying, "I will listen to you anytime."

It is important not to do it alone but to ask for cooperation and assistance from other people in helping a person close to you. Please refer to \(\text{Main windows for consultation} \) during the month to enhance the measures for the prevention of suicide. Won't you start to do something, little by little, for the mental health of people around you?

Vegetable rich recipe recommend (Ishikawa)

(野菜たっぷりおすすめレシピ)

Salad chirashi sushi Ingredients for 4 persons: cooked rice 600g, one third of a carrot, white radish 4 cm, leaves of white radish, shiitake mushroom 4 pieces, green bean 4, aburaage 1, sushi vinegar 4 large spoons, tomato 1, lettuce Yakinori, salad oil,



[A] 4 eggs, water 4 large spoons, sugar 2 small spoons, salt How to make

- ① Cut white radish and carrot the same size, white radish leaves 5 mm. Slice shiitake mushroom, green bean diagonally. Put all vegetable on the plate and wrap with plastic wrap and heat in the microwave 600w for 2 minutes.
- ② Grill aburaage and cut it in rectangles.
- Heat oil in the frying pan, and put A to spread thin. When
 the surface gets dried, stop the fire and place the lid on. Wait
 for 2 minutes.
- 4 Put ③ on a plate and let it cool down, then cut it in four equal portions and thinly slice it
- ⑤ Put the rice, ① ② and sushi vinegar in the bowl and mix.
- Put the lettuce on a plate and then put 5 on it, and put
 on it. Tear the yakinori and put it. Lastly cut a tomato in 8 pieces and arrange them as a decoration.

[A word from the staff for promotion of improved eating habits] This is very simple chirashi sushi, just vegetable cut and heated in the microwave, that is mixed with vinegar rice. You can have enough vegetables and feel full. Grilled aburaage can give a good accent, with a savory smell that makes it delicious with a light taste. The dish is visually colorful with vegetables and eggs, so it looks delicious. It is good for special event days such as girls' festival.
