We are currently rebuilding the school lunch center. We will improve the aging facility and reduce administrative cost. (Scheduled to be completed in April 2019.) We asked the elementary and junior high school pupils and students in the city for the nickname of the kitchen, and "Nashibo Kitchen" was decided by voting.

# Cooperation to watch over the children of after-school day-care centers

(学童保育通所児の見守りに協力を)

Children who use after-school day-care centers go to a school with a day-care center, however, elementary schools in the City will soon be on winter vacation. Recently, malicious crimes aimed at children have occurred in various places, and information on suspicious individuals is also frequently heard. While guardians and care workers pick up and look after the children as much as possible, the system such as looking after is not enough as there are cases where children go to day-care in small groups or less. Not only to protect children who go to day-care schools but also to ensure that children who are on vacation are safe and secure, we would like to ask the local people to watch over the children in the morning and afternoon as you go out for shopping or walking.

# Be careful! Traffic fatality accident frequent occurrence

(注意して!交通死亡事故多発中)

Traffic fatality accidents occur frequently in the Prefecture.

Pedestrians, those riding a bicycle, people driving a car, everyone who uses the road, please make sure to check the safety of front, rear, left, and right at the intersection.

- Many fatal accidents occurred early in the morning or at dusk, in particular. Drivers should make sure of the lights, do a safety check, and especially, drive carefully. Pedestrians should wear bright and conspicuous color clothing and reflective materials when going out.
- •When riding a car, please fasten seat belts at all seats including the back seats and use child car seats.
- If there are pedestrians around the pedestrian crossing, let's ease up on the accelerator and protect them.

# It is being targeted! Be careful of telephone fraud!

(狙われています!電話 de 詐欺に注意!)

In the City, phone calls suspicious of telephone fraud occur frequently, and damages have also occurred. In Chiba Prefecture, calls whose callers pretend as a family member such as son or grandchild frequently occur. After saying, "My mobile phone number has changed." they would tell a problem such as "I took advantage of the company's money." and "I lost my bag containing the company's check." Then to be able to solve the problem, they would ask for money.

If you got "My mobile phone number has changed." call, please make sure to call the original mobile phone number or confirm by making a call to the workplace. Other than this, there are also calls from those pretending to be police officers, bank clerks, and employees of famous department stores. They will make you feel uneasy by saying, "Your card has been illegally used." Then they will say, "Your card needs to be reissued." and try to swindle your cash card by deceitfully asking for your PIN. Police officers and bank clerks never ask for a PIN on the phone nor come to your house to get your cash card.

If you got a phone call about "money" or "card," it is fraud. ""My mobile phone number has changed.", "I want you to give money to an agent.", "Your card is being misused.," and "I will keep your card." calls are a fraud. Never give your money or card, please report and consult with the police.

#### [ Not to suffer any damage ]

- ◆Taking countermeasures on the phone against telephone fraud
- •Let's set our home phone to answering machine mode.
- The best damage prevention measures are "not talking with the criminal" and "not answering the phone from the criminal."
- Even though you think, "I will never be deceived," the criminal has the talking skill to deceive you.
- •If you set your home phone to answering machine mode, you don't need to answer the call from the criminal. It is effective for damage prevention as criminals do not like their voice to be recorded.

# The Ambassador of the Republic of Kazakhstan's Lecture

(「世界最大の内陸国」カザラスタン共和国大使講演会)

Are you interested in learning about different cultures? International Friendship Association of Shiroi (IFAS) has organized 29 ambassador lectures, and various country's ambassadors have been invited to hold a lecture.

This year, the ambassador of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the world's largest landlocked country, will give a lecture.

The date of the lecture is Jan. 26, which is the memorial day for the establishment of diplomatic relations between Japan and Kazakhstan, (established in 1992). Ambassador Yerlan Baudarbek-Kozhatayev will talk about Kazakhstan's culture, history, and the relationship with Japan in Japanese.

# Biography of the Ambassador

Ambassador Yerlan Baudarbek-Kozhatayev was born in 1967. He is fluent in Kazakh, Russian, Japanese and English. He graduated from Kazakh State University. He has been the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Kazakhstan to Japan since May 2016.

The Republic of Kazakhstan borders Russia and China, on the west Caspian Sea, on the east the Altai Mountains. Population 18,200,000 (2017 UN population fund). The area is 2,725,000 km², 7.2 times larger than the area of Japan. Kazakhstan has rich resource of energy and minerals, and Japanese companies participate in its development. % The lecture had been planned for July 2018, but was postponed due to the approaching typhoon.

Shiroi City operates an advisory service to help foreign residents living within Shiroi City solve questions and obtain information related to daily life, city administration, facilities etc.



# Tour of Seven Lucky Gods in Shiroi (しろい七福神めぐり)

 $\sim$ You may attract good fortune! What are Seven Lucky Gods? $\sim$ 

Seven Lucky Gods are the popular Seven Good Fortune Gods common people believe from the Muromachi era to the present.

The "Tour of Seven Lucky Gods" was a widespread custom in the Edo period. It is said that you attract fortune Shichinansokumetsu and Shichifukusokusho (escape from the seven disasters, awarded by seven Gods) by going around the Seven Lucky Gods during Matsunochi (January 1st - 7th).



# He is the laughing god of joy carrying a large sea bream. He is the god of prosperity in

Ebisu

business.



Characterized by his long beard, peculiar head, and carrying a crane, he is the god of three virtues of luck and longevity.

Fukurokuju



Characterized by his big smile and a potbelly, and carrying a large sack of treasures, he is the god of matrimonial happiness and children.

Hoteison



Among the seven lucky gods, he is the only dressed in armor god of warriors. He is also a god of treasure and a very strong god.

Bishamonten



Daikokuten

He is the god of agriculture. He is the god of fortune with a big bag and has short legs.



Benzaiten
She is the god who is good at performing arts such as music and singing. She is the only goddess of the Seven
Lucky Gods said to represent the virtue of marriage.



Jurojin

He holds a scroll and a peach. Accompanied by a deer, he is a personification of a star as Fukurokuju. He is the god of longevity.

# ~Temples in Shiroi where the Seven Lucky Gods are enshrined~ (しろい七福神が祀られる寺院)



①長楽寺/ Chokuraji (Ne 1386 TEL 491-0434) Founded in the second half of 1400, it is next to Takara Kindergarten.



②西輪寺/ Sairinji(Tomizuka 905 TEL 492-0666) It was founded in 1593. The seal (御朱印/goshuin) is at Raikoji.



③来迎寺 / Raikoji(Oritate 266 TEL 492-0877)Founded in the first half of 1200, it has a 400-year old gigantic ginkgo tree.



承本寺 Shuhonji (Shiroi 429 TEL 497-1099) Founded in 1303 with Shiroi Nursery School in the precincts of the temple.



⑤延命寺 / Enmeiji (Hiratsuka 939 TEL 497-0807) Founded in 1005 with about 250-year-old wooden statue of enshrined Daikokuten.



**6**薬王寺 / Yakuoji(Kiyodo 6 TEL 497-0928)Founded around 800 with about 400-year-old wooden statue of enshrined Benzaiten.



⑦佛法寺 / Buppoji (Fuku 987 TEL 491-5758) Founded more than 350 years ago, it holds events such as temple yoga.
