

Recommended recipe with plenty of vegetables (やさいたっぷりおすすめレンピ)

Bacon and cabbage with starchy vegetable sauce

Ingredients: (for 4 people)

Half cabbage (450g), radish 200g, red paprika, 1/2, onion 1/2, komatsuna 50g, bacon 60g (4), 2 cups of water, 1 teaspoon of Chinese Ajinomoto, a little salt and pepper, 1 teaspoon of olive oil, 2 tablespoons of potato starch, 1/2 tablespoon of soy sauce

Preparation:

- 1. Cut cabbage into 4 equal parts and cut other vegetables into 1 cm squares. Cut the bacon into 8 pieces.
- 2. Put bacon in cabbage, put it on a heat-resistant plate, wrap it, and heat it at 600W for 4 to 5 minutes.
- 3. Put water and Chinese Ajinomoto in a pan and simmer. Add cut vegetables and simmer.
- 4. Adjust the taste with salt and pepper, add potato starch dissolved in water to thicken it.
- 5. Sprinkle starchy vegetable sauce on the bacon and cabbage

[A word from a nutritionist]

The sweetness of the vegetables and the saltiness of the bacon are delicious. With this one dish, you can consume two-thirds of the target amount of vegetables a day. The vitamins contained in cabbage protect the mucous membranes of the stomach and duodenum and improve immune

functions. Be careful not to eat too much and drink too much during the New Year holidays, and why not add a side dish full of vegetables that is kind to your body?

How are you? I'm a Physical Therapist (お元気ですか 理学療法士です)

Effects of physical exercise and the importance of muscle

Are you doing physical exercise on a regular basis? Now, the decrease of physical exercise in people's daily life is a concern because people are staying home to avoid infection of the new corona virus. It is generally understood that exercise is good for health but why is it necessary to do physical exercise?

There are two major reasons. One is the prevention of lifestyle diseases. It is good for health that the intake of energy from food and the consumption of energy by exercise are balanced. If you do not exercise enough, the intake of energy exceeds consumption and unused energy is stocked in the body as fat. Unnecessary accumulation of fat is the cause of obesity and obesity can cause diabetes, high blood pressure, dyslipidemia, etc., increasing the risks of lifestyle diseases.

The second reason is the maintenance of muscle strength and physical function. The functions of a

person are lost at a surprisingly fast speed if they are not used. For example, when someone walks, the quadricle of the thigh, anterior tibial muscle, triceps surae and many other muscles are used. Muscles of the hips, back, arms and trunk are also used. That is, you can walk using all the muscles of your body. If you don't walk, many muscles will decrease and your balance and cardiopulmonary functions will deteriorate. It will produce serious effects on your daily life. Every day walking is necessary to avoid such consequences.

Bone mass reaches its peak at 20 years of age and decreases according to increases of age. However, you can increase muscle at any age if you train yourself. Let's maintain and increase muscle by routine physical exercise.
