The national pension is a system in which all people between the ages of 20 and 60 years living in Japan become insured and pay insurance premiums, and support the lives of the people, such as the "Old age pension" received from the age of 65 years, "Disability pension" that you receive when you have a disability, and the "Bereaved family pension" that children receive when the insured person dies.

How are you? I'm a Dental Hygienist

(お元気ですか 歯科衛生士です)

"A mouth is the entrance to health"

* Nasal breathing is a natural mask.

We wear masks more often now to prevent the infection of new corona virus and flu. It's suffocating under a mask and you may be breathing with your mouth.

Even with a mask, dry and cold air in winter may hurt your throat if it comes directly into your mouth. It dries your mouth and can also be the cause of tooth decay, periodontal disease and bad breath. If you do nasal breathing (with your mouth closed), it will make the intake of outside air warm and moist, and nasal mucosa will prevent bacteria and viruses from coming in. Nasal breathing is a natural mask itself.

* Get accustomed to touching your tounge to your upper chin and strengthen the muscle around your mouth.

The point is to keep your tounge touched firmly on your upper chin when you are closing your mouth. Then, the muscles around your mouth will become tense and your face line will be clear. It also will strengthen the muscle to lift your tounge and will be helpful for the prevention of sleep apnea syndrome. * The health of your whole body starts your mouth

Recommended recipe with plenty of vegetables

(やさいたっぷりおすすめレシピ)

Crispy stir-fried komatsuna with rich ginger flavor

Ingredients: (For 4 people)

Komatsuna (a kind of rape plant): 1 bag, Ginger: 2 pcs), Carrot: 1/2 pc, Enoki mushrooms: 1 bag, Salad oil: 1 tablespoon, Noodle soup (double concentrated): 1 tablespoon, Soy sauce: 1 tablespoon, Bonito flakes: appropriate amount Recipe:

- 1. Cut komatsuna into 2-3 cm pieces. Separate leaves and stems.
- 2. Cut ginger and carrot into fine strips. Cut enoki mushrooms into 3 cm pieces after cutting off the ferrule.
- Pour salad oil in a skillet and stir-fry ginger lightly with medium heat till its flavor comes out.
- Add carrot and enoki mushrooms. Continue stir-frying with middle heat. When enoki mushrooms became soft, add the stems of komatsuna and continue stir-frying for about a minute.
- Add leaves and noodle soup to ④ and season it. Serve on a dish and sprinkle bonito flakes on top.



A word from an adviser for the improvement of eating habits

This cuisine promotes appetites with the flavor of ginger and the crispy texture of komatsuna.

The komatsuna becomes crispier if you put it in water before cutting. It has a rich flavor and tastes better because noodle soup is used as seasoning.

The taste will go through and be better as time passes. So, the dish is good for meal prep or for the lunch box.

Notice of Social Insurance Premium, etc.

(社会保険料額のお知らせ)

We will send you a "Notice of the amount of the social insurance premium etc. paid in 2020 that are related to your final tax return, etc." (post card)

This post card is the notice of total amount of social insurance premium, etc. paid to Shiroi city in 2020 and will be sent to you at the end of January 2021. The notice is for your filing of your final tax return.

On the notice, the following three (3) amounts that were paid by payment slip or bank transfer are written; ① National Health Insurance Tax ② Premium for the Latter Stage Elderly Medical

Insurance System ③ Long-term Care Insurance Premium.

To persons whose tax and premium are specially withdrawn from their pension, Japan Pension Service will send "withholding slip for pension etc." Please confirm the amount with the slip.

If you want to confirm the amount of payment early, please apply for the "confirmation of payment" at relevant windows. ID (driver's license etc.) is necessary to receive it.

Hi, Consumer Affairs Center! (はい、消費生活センターです)

A trader called me and said, "We'll buy anything."

Question: A trader called and wanted to visit me. He said, "I'll buy used goods that you don't need anymore." I had unused tableware and asked him to buy it. Can I trust him?

Answer: There are cases of troubles with door-to-door purchase service such as, "The price was lower than the original offer." or "They forcefully bought precious metals after searching in my house."

Decline the visit if you feel anxious. If you could not contact the trader, don't open the door and

reject them firmly when they visit you. If they don't leave, call the police. Door-to door purchasers have an obligation to issue a purchase contract and a cooling-off applies for 8 days. Don't make a deal with a trader who does not issue a contract.

You may find unnecessary goods after housecleaning. But it is dangerous to let an unfamiliar trader come into your house. Be careful! If you have any doubt, please feel free to consult with us.
