# Chiba Prefecture Minimum Wage has been revised (「千葉県最低賃金」が改正)

The "Chiba Prefecture Minimum Wage" was revised to 923 yen per hour (an increase of 28 yen) on October 1, 2019. The revision applies to all workers (including part-time workers) and employers in Chiba Prefecture. Employers cannot employ workers for a wage lower than this amount. Even if employers set a wage lower than the minimum wage, it is deemed invalid by law. The wage must be at least the same as the minimum wage. \*\*Please be aware that "specific (by industry) minimum

wage" other than "Chiba Prefecture minimum wage" may be applied in some industries

# Labor force survey will be carried out



Statistics Bureau of Japan and Chiba Pref. will carry out a Labor force survey to investigate the rates of employment and unemployment.

Researchers with a "researcher identification card" will visit the survey areas and distribute and collect forms.

## Application for After School Care for FY 2020 (「学童保育所」2020年度入所の申し込みを受付)

The city will start to accept applications for the afterschool care of children from April, 2020. Children currently using the service also need to apply if they want to continue receiving the service after April, 2020.

## What is "After School Care"?

This is a place where elementary school children (1-6 grades) who don't have anyone to take care of them can spend their time safely. The goal of the system is to provide children with an appropriate environment for playing and living, and help them grow safe and sound.

### Possible reasons to be qualified

- ① Working parents (Working more than 4 hours a day and more than 12 days a month and coming home after 3 p.m.)
- ② Mother's delivery of baby. (the month of delivery and two months before and after the month of delivery)
- ③ Disease or disability of parents
- 4 Nursing care of family members or relatives living together who are hospitalized or need care.
- ⑤ Disaster restoration from fire etc.
- ⑥ Parents are attending school.
- ② Any other reason that makes it difficult for parents to take care of their children after school.

Until Dec. 27 (Fri). (Applications will be accepted till 7:00 p.m. on every Thursday.)

# Let's cooperate to conserve the water quality of Imba Marsh (前旛沼の永賀保全にご協力を)

October is "Imba Marsh Purification Promotion Month." Let's take some measures at home for the conservation of Imba Marsh water quality.

- Do not put cooking waste down the kitchen sink. Use filter paper bags instead.
- Use cooking oil wisely, and don't pour it down the drain.
- Wipe off oil on tableware and pots before washing them.
- Do not pour the water used to wash rice down the drain. Use it to water plants instead, or use pre-washed rice.
- Use a bucket and a moderate amount of detergent to wash your car.
- Do not use too much soap and detergent.
- Set up sedimentation tanks, and clean gutters and roads.
- Try changing your single septic tank to a merged septic tank, or install an advanced merged septic tank which can remove nitrogen and phosphorus. Also, please take care of your septic tank properly.

# November is the month of strengthening preventative measures of harms by animals

(動物による危害防止対策強化月間)

Be careful not to have accidents or difficulties caused by animals and take care of animals by abiding by the following.

• Dog owners have a duty to register their dog and to ensure the dog has a rabies shot

once a year.

- When your dog bites someone, you need to report the incident to the health center and have the dog examined by a veterinary doctor to check if the dog has rabies.
- When you keep a dog, it must be trained not to cause an accident.
- ◆ It is forbidden to let a dog run loose including in the park. When you walk your dog, the person who can control the dog should do so with a short rope.
- ◆ Keep your dog out of the reach of visitors. Try to keep your dog inside the entrance gate and do not let it run out of the gate.
- Keep cats inside your house. This will prevent problems of feces, urine and cat calls outside your house, and protect cats and humans from the risks of infectious diseases. When you take care of cats that are not kept inside by someone and they live outdoors, be careful not to get too close to avoid being bitten or scratched.
- When you keep more than ten dogs and/or cats, you need to report it to the Health Center. (excluding dogs and cats under 91 days old)
- When you keep a monkey or a snake, you need to get permission from the head of Health Center.

- When your pet is missing, begin a search immediately and report the missing pet to the Health Center, police, and animal protection center by phone. Fix a name tag to your dog or cat or put in a microchip at an animal hospital and register the microchip so that when your dog or cat is found, the owner can be found quickly.
- Take care of your dog or cat with responsibility for its entire life. If you unwillingly or cannot keep it, find a new owner for the animal.

Health Center or animal protection center will help you find a new owner.

 "How to keep a dog · How to train a dog" class is held periodically at the animal protection center. Instructors also go to schools, and hold community classes about animal protection, and infectious diseases that can be caused by animals.

## Inbatoriminogaoka (印波鳥見丘)

In Nara era Wado 6 (713), Fudoki - a description of the natural features, culture and history of a region - was made all over the country by the order of Emperor Genmei . Most of them have been already lost, but Hitachinokuni Fudoki in Ibaraki pref. still remains, and there were many writings concerning Chiba pref.

Especially the origin of Kasumigaura, the name of the place of Kasumigo (Ibaraki pref. Itako city) is very interesting. According to Hitachinokuni fudoki, when Emperor Keigyo walked along Shimousanokuni, Inba, Torimigaoka, he looked to the east and said, "There is a blue ocean wide spread, and the land looked red in the mist with the people who live there." Then the place was called Kasumigo.

Shimosanokuni is the northern part of Chiba pref., Shiroi changed from town to city in Heisei 13 (2001), some of you may remember that Shitoi town belonged to Inba gun. Fudoki says that the place name of Inba has been used for more than 1,300 years.

From ancient times to the Medieval period, at the border of Ibaraki pref. and Chiba pref. there was a water area called "Katori no umi", and Kasumigaura, Inba marsh and Tega marsh were all parts of it. On the other hand, the northern part of Inzai city to Shiroi city Torimi shrine is distributed, and Inba Torimigaoka might have been in the torimi shrine distribution area.

Emperor Keigyo is known as a father of Yamato Takeru. In Nihonshoki, it is said that Yamato Takeru went to Tohoku passing through Chiba to conquer Ezo. Later Emperor Keigyo followed Yamato Takeru's path and travelled around Tohoku. Hitachinokunii Fudoki description coincides with this.

On the other hand, there is a legend of Sawayama fountain in Shiroi city Yata area where Yamato Takeru purified his body. The description of Emperor Keigyo walking around Inba Torimigaoka suggests that Yamato Takeru had been to Inba Torimigaoka, and it is suggested that on the way he might have stopped by Sawayama fountain.

## Consumer Center No. 242 (消費生活センター)

~ Important point of 「Cleaning Trouble」 that increases as the seasons change! ~

"Quite disappointed with the poor finish of cleaning of clothes that I finally took to the laundry." Let's know what to do in advance so as not to experience such happenings.

### (Example 1 of consultation)

I had my new yukata cleaned that I wore only once. The flower patterns on the yukata discolored. (in 20s female)

## (Example 2 of consultation)

My favorite blouse (100% cotton) that I bought last year got sweat stains around the neck and armpit and I took it to a laundry. After cleaning, I put the blouse covered with vinyl in the chest of drawers. The other day, I checked the blouse and found stains of light brown on it. (in 40s, female)

# (Advise from the Consumer Center) (Example 1 of consultation)

Discoloring in the color of design and other colors is one of the common troubles in cleaning. Discoloration relates to the cloth material and its characteristics for holding color. Colors and the texture of color may be eroded by sunburn, sweat, laundering at home and the elapse of time. It is helpful to confirm any warnings at the laundry and hear the details of the methods and risks of cleaning.



Summer clothes may have got more sweat and sebum than usual.
Dry cleaning cannot remove stains made by sweat or water solvable dirt completely. It is possible that the stain remaining on the clothes was oxidized and yellowed because the

clothes was kept at home for a while. It is

important that you explain the purpose of cleaning at the reception of the laundry if you want to have sweat stain removed. One of the ways to remove sweat stain is wet cleaning. However, there is the risk of shrinkage in wet cleaning depending on the material, so you should confirm the method of cleaning and its risk with the laundry.

\*A laundry has responsibility to explain to the client the method of cleaning as well as the works done in the method and the risk involved. As soon as you receive the clothes after cleaning, you should open them and confirm if there is any tear, new stain or discoloration. It will help you to confirm also the base for damage compensation beforehand.

## (nurse Katsura Prevention of Influenza)

(インブルエンザを予防しよう)



The peak of influenza epidemics is around
January to February. The reason why it is
prevalent in winter is the virus lives long in
low temperatures and dry conditions, and
nose mucous membrane becomes weak with
cold dry air. It is also due to people travelling
during year end and New year days, causing

influenza to spread all over Japan.

Be aware of the steps we can take in our daily life to prevent influenza. Influenza vaccinations should be done in December to get immunity before the epidemic peak.

Steps to prevent influenza

- 1. Wash hands and gargle after returning home.
- 2. Refrain from going to crowded places while influenza is prevalent.
- 3. Rest well, develop strength and build resistance, having a good balance of meals.
- 4. Use a humidifier to maintain a moderate temperature and low humidity.
- 5. Practice good coughing etiquette.
- Wear a mask while coughing or sneezing
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue paper while coughing or sneezing, and keep at least 1~2 meters away from others as possible
- Throw tissues used for runny noses into the trash can.
- Wash hands promptly after covering your runny nose or after blowing your nose.

## **Cervical Cancer and Breast Cancer** Screening (Individual examination)

For individual examination of cervical and breast cancer, reservation with a designated

medical institution by phone will be accepted until

November 30 (Sat). If you have the medical questionnaire sheet on hand and have not received a consultation yet, please make a reservation early. If you do not have the questionnaire sheet yet and want to see a doctor, please apply to Health Section. Cervical cancer and breast cancer screenings are conducted once every two years, so those who took them last year are not eligible. Cervical cancer and Breast cancer screening: designated medical institution list

#### [Prostate Cancer Screening]

Prostate cancer screening is carried out at the designated medical institution in the city for men aged over 50 years old with even number of age (as of March 31, 2020). From the age of 50 years and older, the risk of getting prostate cancer increases significantly and it is necessary to take the screening regularly. The prostate cancer screening is available until January 31, 2020. If you don't have the questionnaire at hand and want to take the screening, please apply to Kenko-ka or Health Section. \*Please contact us to ask about the designated medical institutions in the city.

### [Colon Cancer Screening]

With the westernization of our dietary habits, the number of people suffering from colon cancer is increasing greatly. The city conducts screenings for colon and gastric cancer on the same day with a barium test. Only seven days are left this year. Please take the test at your earliest convenience. If you do not have the questionnaire sheet and want to take the screening, please apply to Health Section.

## NOVEMBER IS A CAMPAIGN MONTH FOR PREVENTION OF CHILD ABUSE

(11月は児童虐待防止推進月間)

### ~ A Child may be saved by your phone call ~

Some parents believe in disciplining children physically. However it is not discipline if the child sees it as violence. It is "Child Abuse". Child abuse should be judged not by the abuser's perspective but from child's viewpoint. When you notice a child who seems to be ill-treated around you, just call and report the situation to the city's Health and Welfare consultant or Prefecture's Child consultant office (calls will be kept confidential). Your call may save a child.

#### Child abuse includes the following:

Physical violence: bodily harm in the form of beating, kicking, dropping down, or shaking a baby hard, shutting the child out of the house, inflicting burns, or for a child to be in fear of such deeds.

**Mental abuse:** Saying hurtful words, ignoring or threatening, demanding something unsuitable for the child's age, committing violence against the partner in front of a child, discriminating among brothers and sisters.

**Sexual abuse:** molesting, forcing sexual relations, showing sexual acts, and forcing a child to model for pornography

**Neglect (inappropriate bringing up):** providing no food, no bathing, giving no medical treatment, leaving alone at home or in a car, not letting the child go to school against his/her wish and so on.

### What you can do to prevent child abuse

## ♦ If you find a child who might be abused

It is the duty of people to tell. You need to report the situation if you find or hear what you think may be abuse. Your contact can mean the protection of a child and support for parents.

### You can have support

When you are unsure and have concerns on bringing up a child, talk to family, friends, or with someone at the City's Health and Welfare Center consultation or Prefecture's Chuo Jido Sodanjo (child consultation office).

## Make warm eye contact with parents and children

When you see parents and children in the neighbor or various places, make warm eye contact with them. If you smile to children or help carrying a baby carrier, the parents and children will feel comfortable and happy.


